Excerpts from the official report of Conferring Officer John Jedlicka to the state officer of ceremonials that he was required to give following the ceremony.

“By far it was the largest and most successful Third Degree exemplification in the modern history of the Jurisdiction of Georgia. Under my direction as Conferring Officer the William Layburn Third Degree Team exemplified 114 candidates.

District Deputy Guy Stryker mobilized the Council officers to ensure a successful degree and they responded marvelously. Remember, Gary, we had to manage a triple-digit candidate class. GK Louis Hlad created a team of Brother Knights who prepared the Chamber the night before so we were ready for Saturday morning. DGK Dennis Caniglia and Warden Joseph Fuentes led the volunteer kitchen crew (I counted at least ten Brother Knights) to feed over 150 men following the degree.

I am the senior active Conferring Officer in the Jurisdiction of Georgia with 12 years under my belt (sash? robe?) and never have I seen a council prepare for an exemplification with such readiness as the Host Council 11402.” John Jedlicka, Conferring Officer

Meet Our Newest Dunwoody Councilman

On September 16th, Georgia's newest city of Dunwoody elected its first government. Our own third-degree brother John Heneghan won the city wide Council District Post 5 (Eastern) seat over his opponent May Jo Chambliss with 66% of the vote.

His victory was especially remarkable because he was a federal employee and could not accept campaign funds. Using only business cards, personal appearances, and his Dunwoody North Subdivision web site, he was the second highest vote-getter, save for the unopposed mayor-elect.

Another brother, Bob Fiscella, was not successful in the central Dunwoody district race. He entered the fray late and was heavily outspent by two other candidates. He did garner 20% of the vote, and thus forced a run-off that will require the other candidates to curry his favored recommendation.

Two other brothers, Don Converse and Dennis Crean, were very active in the evolution of the city. We couldn't be prouder of our civic-minded members.

Another All Saints parishioner, Danny Ross, also won an at-large Council seat. He has thus far declined past invitations to join the Council because of his busy schedule. He is deeply involved in several civic pursuits.

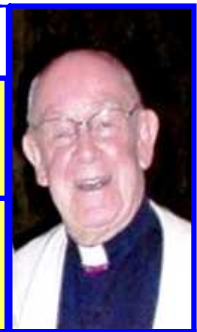
