**December BINGO** will be on **Thursday, December 15th**.

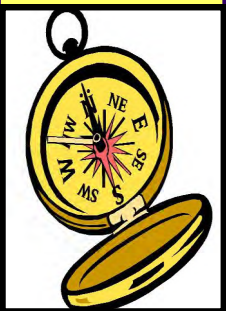

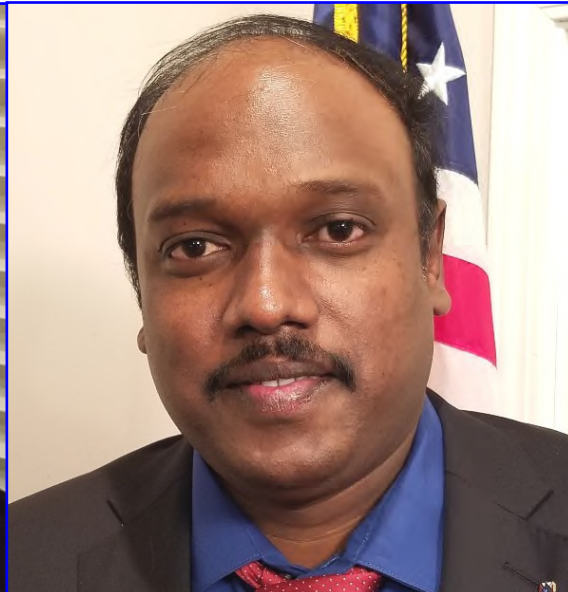
# New 1st Degree Brothers in November

## Ongoing Homeless Shelter Needs

Our Homeless Shelter Director, Len Dorrien, needs ongoing volunteer help staffing the remainder of the ten Sundays that are assigned to All Saints Parish. The shelter is divided between two adjacent buildings (The Shrine of the Immaculate Conception and Central Presbyterian Church near the state capitol building). About 100 men are served in total. The dates of November 20th and January 8th are assigned specifically to our council, but parish help is needed on all these dates. Do not limit your help to the two council dates.

Parish women cook and donate the food required to feed 100 men, while parish men serve the meal and staff the facility through the night in a friendship and supervisory role. This ministry is perhaps our most fulfilling one done by our council every year. You will go home with a renewed concept for your own blessings. Shown above is the new electronic payment page on our council [kc11402.org](http://kc11402.org) web site. You go to that web site, choose "Members Enter Here", log in with your last name and membership number (on your member card), choose "2017 Dues Payment", and then get to above screen.

You may then pay your dues (\$41.50 which includes a small electronic processing fee) by using a credit card **or** your PayPal account which takes that amount directly out of your checking account like a debit card. Your personal PayPal account must be set up independently. A new second web page choice allows you to set up automatic \$41.50 PayPal payments for 5 years.

Of course, you may still pay your unchanged 2017 annual dues of \$40 directly at a meeting or send a \$40 check made out to "**KofC Council 11402**" to our new Treasurer, Dominic Palermo. We could not make it easier to pay your dues. Dues were due last January 1st.



# Bill Florence Sr. Passes

FLORENCE, William Boyd William "Bill" Boyd Florence, 83, passed away peacefully on Oct. 31, 2016, at his home in Dunwoody, Ga. A native of Atlanta, Bill was born in 1933 at Georgia Baptist Hospital. He is preceded in death by his father, Boyd Florence, his mother, Amanda Eunice, and his sister Sara Florence. Bill attended Brown High School where he dated and fell in love with his chemistry partner and future wife, Barbara Ann Bolen. In 1951, he enrolled in Georgia Tech, but left in November 1953, to voluntarily enlist in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. He rose to the rank of sergeant before being honorably discharged in 1955. He kept the same rank while continuing to serve in the U.S. Army Reserve until 1961. On May 15, 1955, Bill and Barbara were married at Calvary Methodist Church. Bill began working as a boat salesman at Pyron and Garrow before his lifelong love of automobiles led him to begin an automotive sales career at Ritz Oldsmobile in East Point. From Ritz he moved to Mitchell Motors Oldsmobile/Rolls-Royce, where he worked 34 years, quickly rising from a salesperson to sales manager and general manager. In 1989, Bill joined the Hennessy family automotive organization. He began working at Hennessy Cadillac and then accepted a management opportunity to open Hennessy Lexus, Atlanta's first Lexus dealership. As new car sales manager and then general sales manager, Bill spent 21 years working for the Hennessy family. "Honest" was a word used by customers in describing what they liked best about Bill a quality he demonstrated daily and instilled in the men and women who worked with him. On Nov. 8, 2005, after a period of health issues, Bill received a kidney transplant at Emory University Hospital, a generous gift of love from Martina Lyons. Bill and his family were so thankful to Martina that they celebrated her donation by

hosting an annual kidney party in her honor. Bill also greatly appreciated the medical expertise, professionalism, and friendship of Dr. Sudha Tata, along with the nurses and entire staff of the Emory kidney transplant unit. Bill became a lifelong fan of The University of Georgia football and men's basketball programs during the 1970s; from 1975 to 1995, he attended 212 consecutive football games. From 1969 until 2006, Bill, Barbara, and their four boys lived on Lake Spivey in Jonesboro. The Florence home was the setting of fish-fries, water-skiing afternoons, and cookouts. It also was the home where Bill and his beloved Labrador retriever, Georgia, spent endless hours together. Bill is survived by his wife, Barbara, of Dunwoody, Ga.; sons Bill and his wife Kim Florence of Dunwoody; Bobby and his wife Lisa Florence of Navarre, Fla.; Tommy and his wife Kathy Florence of Dunwoody; Michael and his wife Deirdre Florence of West End, N.C.; grandchildren Natalie Severy, Andy Florence, Jill Florence, Jackie Florence, Hannah Florence, Amanda Florence and Will Florence III; great-grandchildren Christopher, Andi, and Chuck Severy; close family friend and "fifth adopted son" Gene Gaultney, his wife Carol, and children Nicholas, Ally, and Dustin of Dunwoody; and caregiver and special friend Janet Simon of Norcross. A private family service will be held at Westview Cemetery. Bill's life will be celebrated at a ceremony for family, friends, and work colleagues on Nov. 13, at 2p.m., at Hennessy Lexus at 5955 Peachtree Industrial Blvd. in Atlanta. 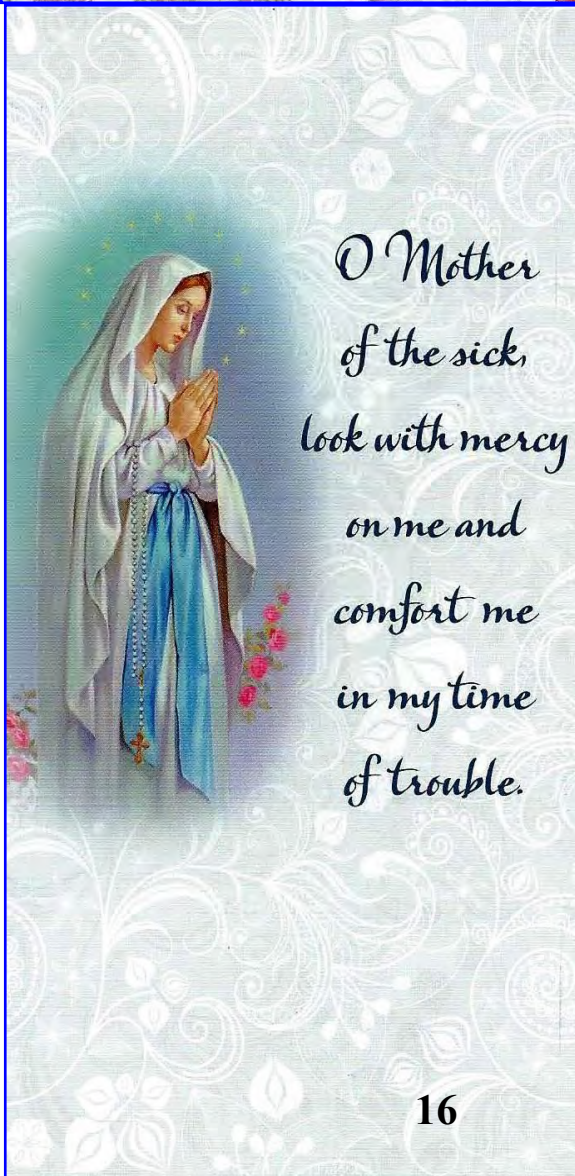
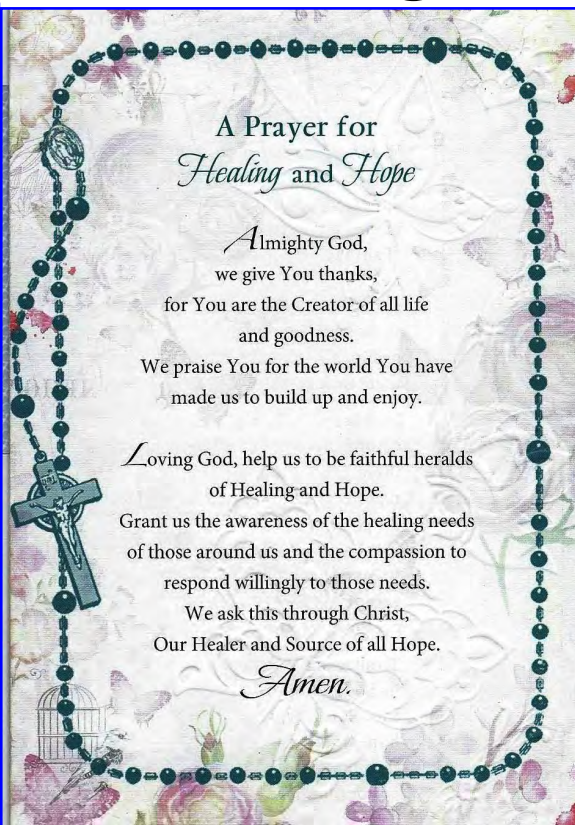

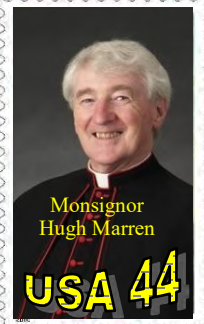
