Grand Knight's Report

Brothers,

We began the new Fraternal Year with a healthy council consisting of 311 members.

We read in seven new candidates at our July meeting on July 6 and another two at the first degree at Mary Our Queen Parish on July 22. We will need to keep up our recruiting efforts if we want to continue being a double star council for the 2010-2011 Fraternal Year, but we are off to a healthy start.

July started with our participation in the Dunwoody Independence Day Parade and Celebration. Kudos to Greg Crnkovich, Bruce Malinoff and their crew or Knights, family members and friends that turned some lumber, paint, napkins and chicken wire into a parade float, complete with a waiving likeness of Monsignor Kiernan. The cooker was also busy preparing sausage, pepper and onion sandwiches at the end of the parade at Dunwoody Village.

Thanks to Dennis Caniglia and John Knight for their culinary expertise and to Bob Fiscella and all the brothers who helped pull off this event on relatively short notice – besides having a lot of fun, rumor has it we even made some money!

Our 52" high def TV is now connected to a Dish Corp Satellite System so we can get sports, entertainment, educational and religious programming in the Council Chambers at McGivney. Our first "event" was on July 13th when more than a dozen brothers and some family members gathered to watch the Major League All Star game.

In addition to the game, the participants were treated to peanuts, as well as chili dogs, "red hots" and popcorn prepared by our Worthy Warden Joey Fuentes (and at much better prices than at Turner Field!!). We expect to hold more sports evenings, social and educational events at McGivney.

Your officers and program chairs have been busy planning the budget and schedule of events for the upcoming fraternal year.

We will be voting on the budget at the upcoming August meeting. The proposed budget has some modest increases from last year's actual expenditures, but is a bit less than last year's budget. I think it is realistic, even in the current economic climate.

Moreover, we should not let "little details" like a recession dampen our enthusiasm for performing the charitable services and participating in the fellowship events that are being planned.

Your Program Director, Bruce Malinoff, has been working with his committee chairs to put together a schedule of events for this year. In addition to the familiar events such as Desserts with Santa, the Lenten Fish Fry and the Vidalia Onion Sale, there will be some new additions.



We are planning to revive the tradition of a second monthly meeting (which is actually called for in the Council bylaws). This will be a purely social event – no "business" to be conducted. We are also working on having entertainment and possibly educational or informational presentations either in connection with this "second meeting" or at a different time, a time that will be more open. They will not be limited to "members in good standing" like the business meetings, but will be open to spouses, family and friends.

Our support of parish youth continues in August as we host our annual Altar Server Outing on Saturday, August 14th, a **Welcome Back to High School Cookout** at our McGivney Hall on Sunday, August 15th, after 6 PM Mass, and a **Welcome Back to College Cookout** with Father Bryan Small at Emory Catholic Center on Wednesday, September 1.

Our fourth degree brothers, will be installing their officers for the Charles Watters Assembly on Saturday, August 21 at All Saints after the 5 PM Vigil Mass. A reception will follow. We are also planning to have a 1st degree exemplification here at McGivney. — tentatively scheduled for Tuesday August 31.

Looking a bit further down the road, we will have "Knights Day" at the All Saints Habitat for Humanity House – get your hammers ready; the Council Memorial Mass for deceased Brother Knights on Wednesday, Oct 13 at 6:30 PM (with a reception to follow); the Tootsie Roll Drive will be coming up in October, as will the **Keep Christ in Christmas** religious card sale.

We are also planning to have regular 1st degree exemplifications on the last Tuesday of each month.

It looks like it's going to be another busy fall.

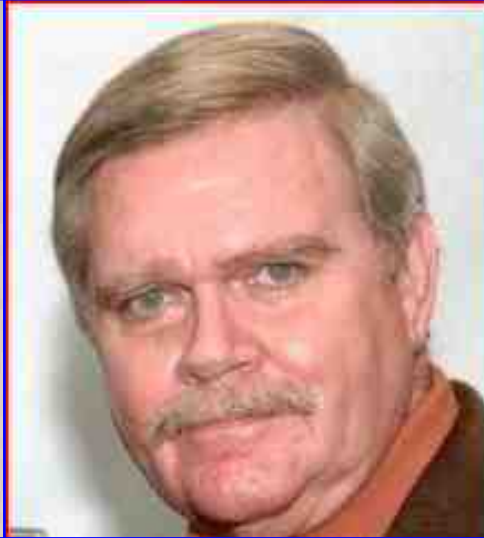

The future of technology came to our McGivney Hall just in time for the 2010 Major League All-Star Game on July 13th. We had a high definition satellite dish and receiver installed at the hall. Our existing 52-inch Samsung high definition TV made a good combination for the new equipment.

About 20 brothers stopped by to see the game and the new equipment in action. The dish is a product of the Dish Network Corporation and we have a plan that includes about 130 channels, including regional sports programming. The actual dish sits on the roof just above the main McGivney door and has a clear view of the Southern sky for excellent satellite reception.

It is our intention to host social nights for our brothers, friends, and candidates to view events, such as Monday Night Football, Braves games, World Series, college football, horse derbies, March Madness, NASCAR, and other events. Our poker playing guys will enjoy some live TV as they play as well.

Think of a “Low Country Boil” as a fish fry without any fish, but with dancing. This food fest is the kind of eatin’ event typically held in the coastal areas of South Carolina or other southern low country regions. It consists of simple fare like some unpeeled shrimp, sausage, corn-on-the-cob, red potatoes, corn bread, a wedge salad, sweet tea, and lemonade. Get some ladies from the Women’s Guild to bake and sell goodies during the meal and you’ve got yourself a party, even before the music begins.

If the photos look just like one of our fish fries (except for the dancing), it’s because we used the very same team captains and team members and just changed the food, since June 26th wasn’t in Lent. Who knows how many different themes we can think up for some parish fun. Profits went to parish ministries and not the knights. Our very first attempt sold 343 meals.



Continuing Charitable/Benevolence Efforts

Our council benevolence continued at the July Business Meeting and during the entire month of July.

The Council officers voted favorably on these charitable and Council expenses:

- ❑ The council continues to collect donations made in the name of the Sir Knight Dave Moeller Memorial Fund for a purpose to be named. The fund is now over \$1,400.
- ❑ The Council voted a \$250 donation to Troop 434 Boy Scout Connor Williams' Eagle Scout project of an outdoor classroom at Dunwoody Elementary School.
- ❑ The Council voted \$500 to the African Mission Ministry of Sir Knight Gray Plunkett in Benin. He asks individual contributions from brothers as well.
- ❑ The Council voted to install a satellite system in McGivney Hall to foster future sport fellowship events. The first one held was the 2010 MLB All-Star Game.

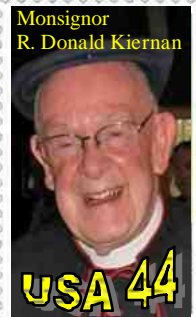
