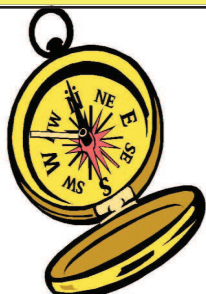

And so, our Father, we thank You for the promise and hope of this new year, and we look forward to it with expectancy and faith.

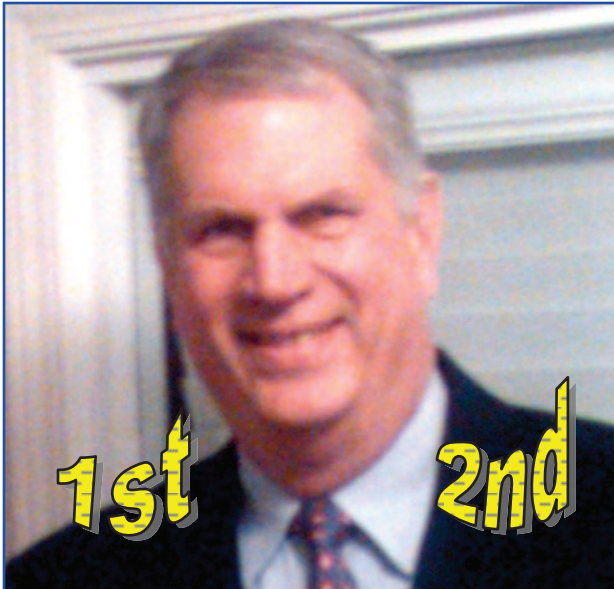
We ask this in the name of our Lord and Savior, who by His death and resurrection has given us hope both for this world and the world to come. Amen.

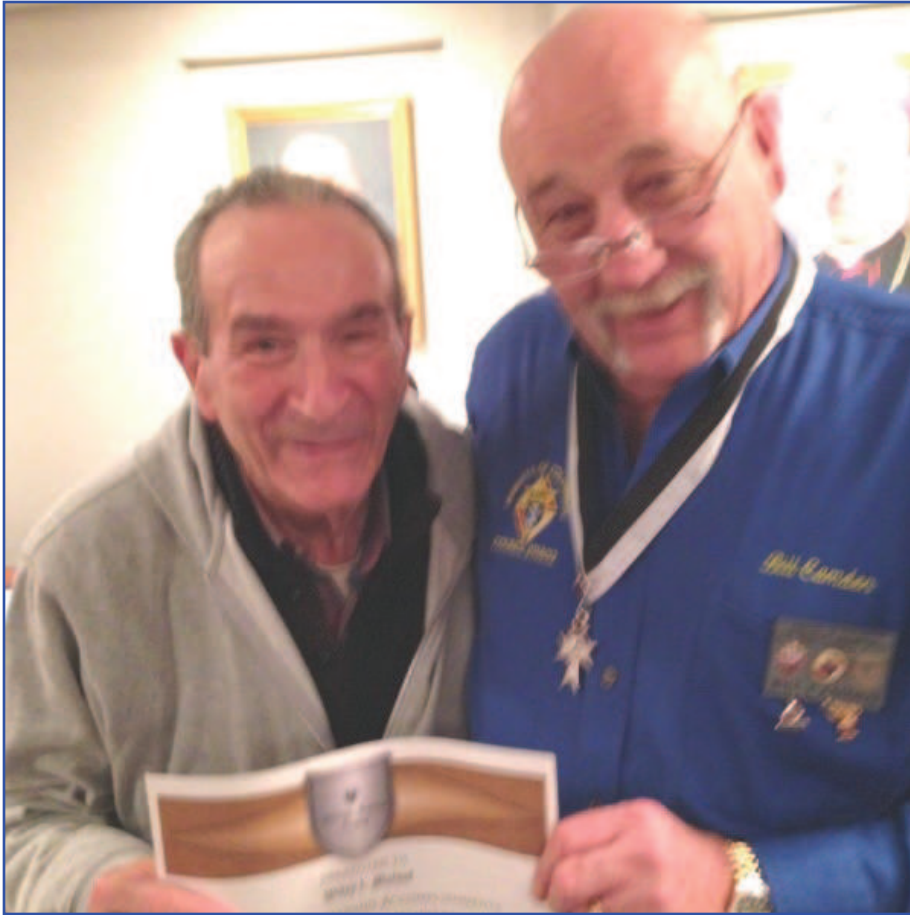

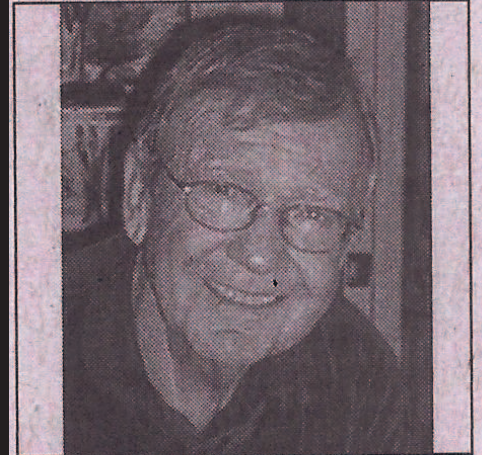

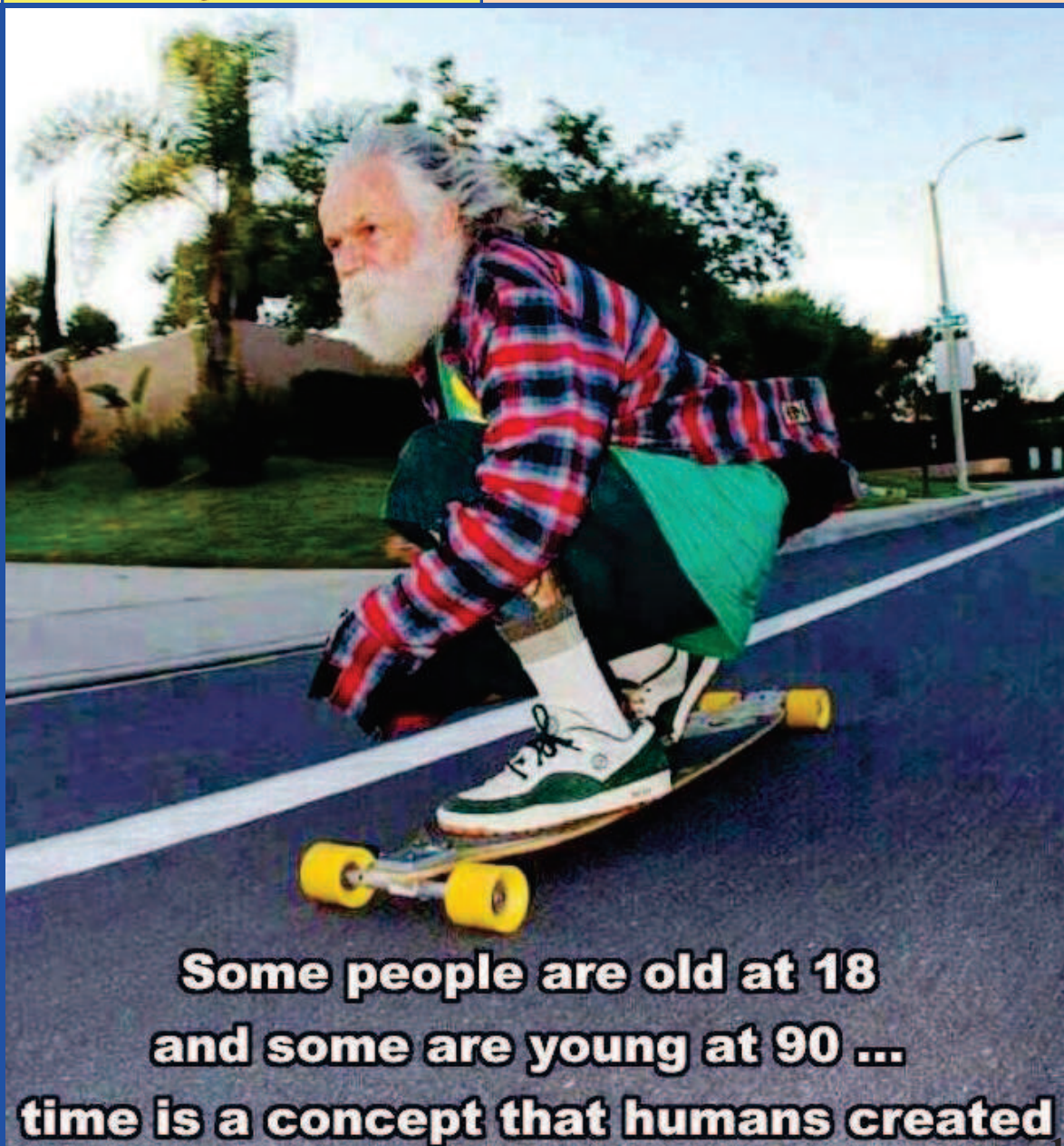
Prayer for Life

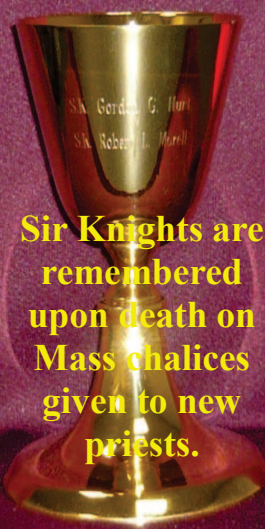

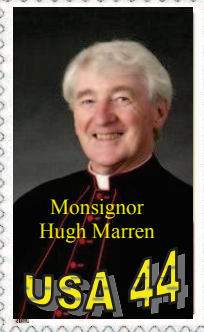
