Continuing Charitable Benevolence Efforts

Our council benevolence continued at the May Business Meeting and during the entire month:

- The Charity Review Committee reported favorably on a request by John Klapka to donate \$250 to *Mary's Shelter* located in the hurricane-devastated area, near where he has a second home in the gulf area of Alabama. At the meeting an amended motion was made to increase the donation to \$500. The motion was passed and Jack will hand carry the \$500 check to the shelter for us.
- A donation of \$250 was reported favorably by the Charity Review Committee on a request by Brother Jon Bird to *Perimeter Adult Learning & Services* (PALS) and that motion was passed and a check was delivered.
- Favorable discussion continues on the donation to the *Sister Sullivan Center*. Mike Will continues looking into the situation. A dollar estimate will follow later.
- Brother Joe Fuentes donated time and engineering talent to the Soap Box Derby event, building our council racer and being a big brother to the All Saints cub scout, Spencer Woolson, who will be our driver. Joe Cavallaro will also direct his business *Collisions of Wheels* entry. This derby is one of the best youth events held in the nation.
- Several brothers served on degree teams during exemplification ceremonies.
- Brothers Cmkovich, Durthaler, Francis, Tobia, and Cygnarowicz continue as RCIA and adult education mentors.
- Brother Gray Plunkett is still in Benin, Africa to translate the Bible into Foodoo language.
- Brother Tom Burleigh donated his time and SUV to pick up vestments to be used in Monsignor's 60th anniversary.
- Several Knights manned the beverage concession for Monsignor's 60th anniversary party. New brother Steve Craine donated beverages. Lou Hlad and Harvey Moskowitz were two of 11 presenters at the event.
- Several brothers continue their Honor Guard activities in the Waters Assembly. Many events were held last month.
- Brother Kirby Baden and wife Sandra run the St. Vincent DePaul Society at our church.
- Several brothers continue to provide usher and door greeting service ministries for our parish.
- Brother Tom Simon is the president of the men's club and also of ICARE senior medical visit driver ministry.

Council to Donate Water Fountains to Church

And, oh yes, there will be a plaque noting that the Knights have donated it.



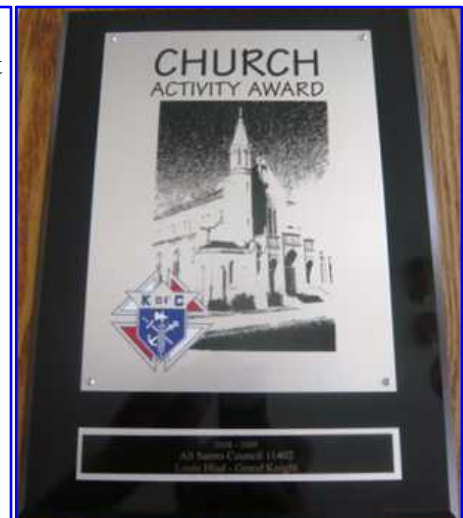
Our Acolyte Program Wins Top State Award

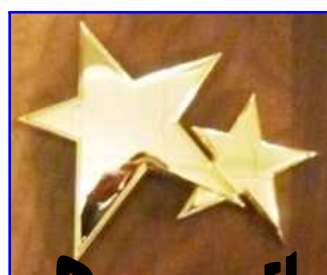
