Although the Knights of Columbus is a relatively small organization in Pope Francis' native Argentina, at a recent audience with the Knights Board of Directors, he praised the Knights for working towards the renewal of society through charitable efforts, prayer and

the witness of their lives. And the Pope thanked the Knights for prayers on his behalf.

"On this occasion I also wish to express my gratitude for the unfailing support which your Order has always given to the works of the Holy See," Pope Francis said.

"This support finds particular expression in the Vicarius Christi Fund, which is an eloquent sign of your solidarity with the Successor of Peter in his concern for the universal Church, but it is also seen in the daily prayers, sacrifices and apostolic works of so many Knights in their local Councils, their parishes and their communities."

The Vicarius Christi (Vicar of Christ) Fund is an initiative that supports the Pope's personal charities.

Pope Francis voiced hope that prayer, witness and charity may remain the *"pillars"* of the Knights' work, collectively and individually. He called for the Knights to continue in fidelity to the mission of our founder, Venerable Father Michael McGivney, seeking *"new ways of being a leaven of the Gospel and a force for the spiritual renewal of society."*


"As the present Year of Faith draws to its close, I commend all of you in a special way to the intercession of Saint Joseph, the protector of the Holy Family of Nazareth," the Pontiff said.

He pointed to St. Joseph as *"an admirable model of those many virtues of quiet strength, integrity and fidelity which the Knights of Columbus are committed to preserving, cultivating and passing on to future generations of Catholic men."*





Progression to Second Degree







Father Dan Rogaczewski Transfers into 11402



It finally happened! Sir Knight Father Daniel J. Rogaczewski decided to transfer into All Saints Council. He had been a member in good standing with the Archbishop James P. Lyke Council 11458 in Fayetteville, Georgia. He was officially read into and voted into our 11402 before the October 22nd first degree in McGivney.

He had always been a 4th degree member of our own Fr. Charles J. Watters Assembly 2688 also headquartered at All Saints, but was not a member of our council. 

Parish Pumpkin Patch Garners Publicity






Parish Pray & Play Meadow Dedicated




