

Seminarian Brother John Klein Goes to Rome

Here is an update from our 1st degree council member, Brother John Klein, LC, from Rome. He has now entered into Theology study for the next three years. He is an ordained Brother of the Legionaires of Christ and is working toward the priesthood.

Our own council member will become our <u>fourth seminarian</u> for RSVP (Refund Support Vocation Program). We will attempt to obtain updates like this from each of our four seminarians and pass them along to the members showing the immense value of this Order-wide RSVP program we support. Brother Klein has volunteered to give any of his council brothers a private tour of Rome, if we happen to visit there.



I hope that this finds all of you well as you begin a new school or work year. Wow, tomorrow will be the end of my first 5 weeks in Rome. It has flown by so quickly. In the midst of all of the business though, I have had many of you in mind. God is good and is leading all of us on an adventure. The more we surrender ourselves to Christ and launch out into the unknown for Him the more we find he guides us to ever more beautiful and diverse paths. I just wanted to share a few things that have been happening with me these past weeks since you all too are a part of my vocation and mission. God in a special way has called me to pray for each of you and share my life with you! Thank you for all your prayers for me!

So far I am doing okay with the languages. I am starting to more or less understand and communicate in Spanish in the house with the brothers. As well, I can understand some of the homilies we have been receiving in Italian

since we had a two week intensive Italian course upon arrival here. Learning new languages is a very humbling experience because you have to become as a child again relearning how to say the most basic of phrases. This new language experience is a great way for me to trust more in God. It is hard but trusting is never easy.

I have had the grace to get out into the city of Rome about 10 times already. The Vatican Museums, which houses much of the most famous works of Raphael and Michelangelo, is breathtaking. The Sistine Chapel is gorgeous as well. Hopefully you all once in your life will get to make it out here and see it. Five million people a year go through the Vatican Museums! St Peters Basilica, as well, is the most incredible building I have ever stepped it. Its size is tremendous and the art timeless. God has reserved this wonder of the world rightfully for Himself and His Vicar the Pope! As well I have gotten to visit many of the other Basilicas here (where I pray for all of you!) and plazas.

We had the grace to host 140 newly ordained bishops from around the world here this past week. Each year the Congregation for Bishops has a week-long training for newly ordained bishops and our seminary hosts it. It was a grace to be able to serve and attend to all the bishops. As a treat too, we had a different Cardinal celebrate mass for us every day! The first day was Cardinal Pietro Parolin the Secretary of State for the Vatican (2nd behind the Pope in authority in the Church!) come and celebrate Mass for us. I as well got to serve the Mass. Pretty neat! During the week we also had a beautiful Mass with the bishops in St Peters. There were 3 Bishops from Iraq and Syria too and they gave us some talks on how the Christians in Iraq are faring against ISIS. The situation is not good so please pray for those suffering in Iraq and Syria. As well always pray for your local bishops, they have much more than we can imagine on their plates each day.

Finally this week we have a few days to breathe before we start 8 days of Spiritual Exercises (a 8 day silent retreat made annually). The retreat for us starts on Friday of this week. Soon after it ends, on Oct 6th, we start classes. I will be beginning my first of 3 years of theology, my last three years before ordination!

Thank you for your prayers and I wish all of you a grace filled few months. You are in my prayers and please email me if you ever plan on heading out to Rome so I can meet up with you!!!
