Grand Knight's Report

Worthy Brothers:

Our Grand Knight Jim Miranda has asked for a temporary leave of absence from his duties as Grand Knight. Jim's professional responsibilities have taken him out-of-state for the remainder of this calendar year, plus he and his wife Amy are expecting a child in early January. To that end, Jim has asked that the Deputy Grand Knight (Greg Crnkovich) takeover the duties of the Grand Knight from October 1, 2005 until the regularly scheduled business meeting on February 7, 2006. The Officers and Trustees of your Council have granted this request. We know that you will join us in offering our support and prayers for Jim and his family over the next few months. We look forward to his return early next year.

Council 11402 has big plans for the month of October! There are three events that heavily involve the Knights. The first is a pasta dinner to be held in the All Saints gymnasium on Friday, October 14 from 4:30 PM to 8:00 PM. The idea for a pasta dinner was offered by Brother Knight Benny Mastrogiovanni at the September meeting. Brother John Buchholz approached the committee coordinating All Saint's response to Katrina with the idea, which was well received. Many of you know that All Saints parish has established a partnership with the storm-damaged parish of Our Lady of the Gulf to assist it in recovering from Hurricane Katrina. The Officers and Trustees met in Executive Session on Saturday, September 24 and agreed to assist with this dinner. The proceeds of the dinner will go directly to Our Lady of the Gulf. There is more information on this dinner later in this newsletter.

The second event is our annual Keep Christ in Christmas holiday card sales. Brother Gert Kampfer is heading up this activity. Please see the details on the next page.

Our third October events is the annual NASCAR fund-raising activity on Sunday, October 30. For the past six years Council 11402 has been invited to send help to the catering service manning the hospitality booths at Atlanta Motor Speedway. Each volunteer earns between \$50 and \$60 for the Council, plus gains free admission to the race. Volunteers are expected to show up on race day from 6AM thru 12:30 PM.

Foodservice ends just before the race begins, so volunteers can enjoy a full-day of racing after helping the Council. In past years, we've averaged around 25 participants. This is a great fund-raiser for our Council, and a whole lot of fun to boot. Volunteers should report to McGivney Hall at 4:15 AM on race-day, to car-pool to the track. Please note that the Georgia Right to Life Committee will be holding its annual Georgia State meeting on October 15, 2004. Before the Council:

There are two motions before the Council that we must vote upon during our November business meeting on November 8.

The first is a motion made by Brother John Buchholz (and seconded), to wit:

"Be it resolved that, in support of the All Saints Katrina Relief Pasta dinner to benefit Our Lady of the Gulf parish in Bay St. Louis, MS to be held on October 14, 2005, that Council 11402 donate the material supplies and foodstuffs and the labor necessary to provide for this dinner as our Council's contribution to the All Saints Katrina relief effort."

Background and additional information: We anticipate that the expenses for this dinner will run approximately \$1500. Our Council has a credit balance of \$525 at US Foods remaining from the last Fish Fry which we'll use to help offset this expense. Should this motion not

pass, we would be required to deduct our expenses from the proceeds of the dinner, thus reducing the amount donated to Our Lady of the Gulf.

The Women's Guild of All Saints has agreed to provide desserts for this dinner, and will be donating the entire proceeds of their sale to Our Lady of the Gulf, including the cost of the materials.

The second item concerns the Council's budget for Fraternal Year 2005-2006. It was Grand Knight Jim Miranda's intention that the Council vote to approve the budget as prepared by the Officers and Trustees. To that end, copies of the budget were circulated to the membership in attendance at the September, 2005 meeting. So that all Brothers may see the budget, a copy of the budget is included with this newsletter. We will make a motion to approve the budget, as presented, at the November 8, 2005 meeting.
