Our next Business meeting is Tuesday night, March 3, at 7:30. The Rosary is optional at 7:00.

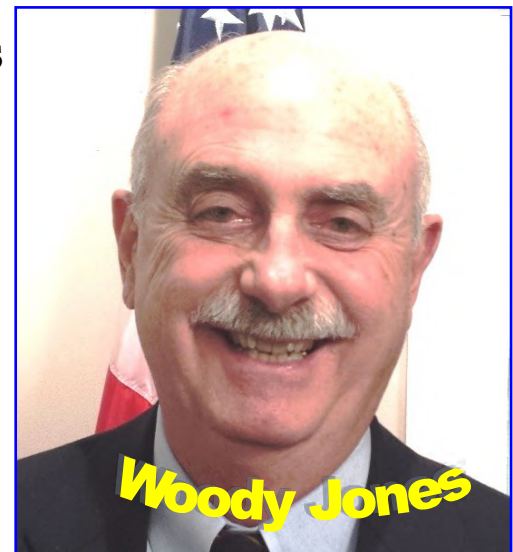

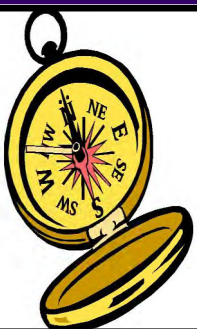
Bingo—is Thursday night, March 26. Doors open at 6:30 and play begins at 7:30. The cost is \$18 for 10 games.

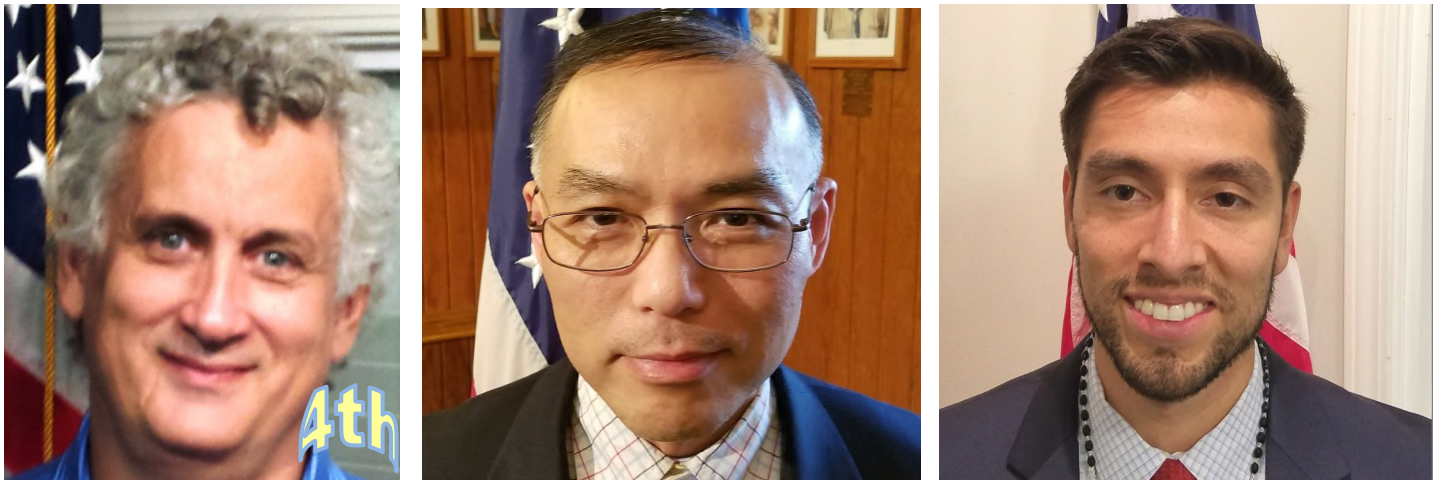

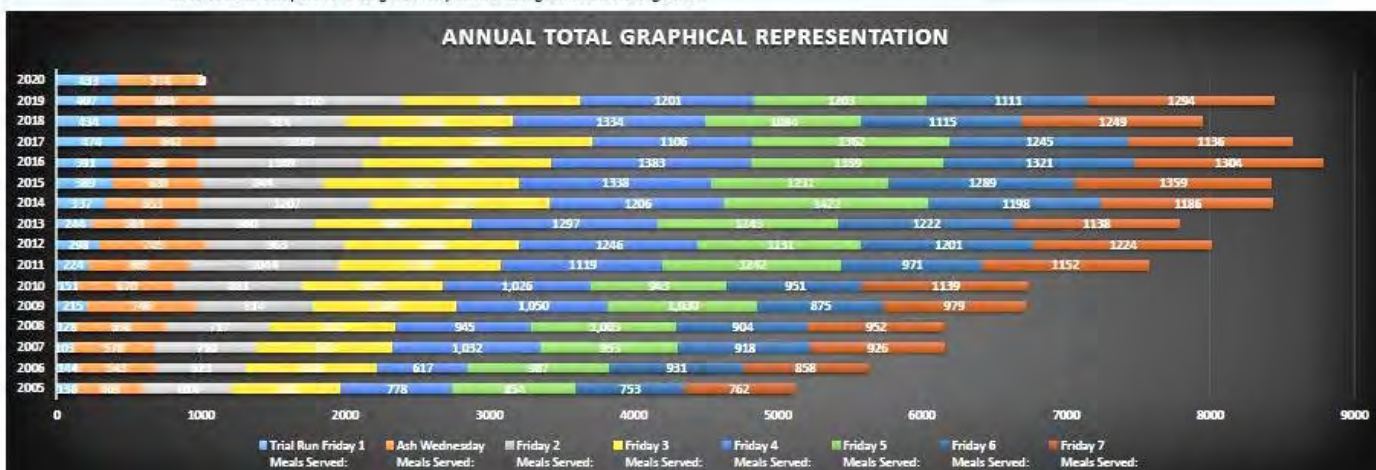
