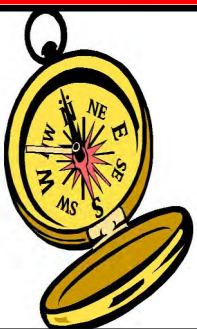

# Paying Council Dues Electronically

Members are a little confused as to the proper procedure for paying dues electronically. Sending a check for \$40 by snail mail still works perfectly well also. Those liking immediate gratification may use the instructions below for a small processing fee.

Brothers,

Regular Council 11402 dues for 2021 are \$40.

Our council website [www.kc11402.org](http://www.kc11402.org) handles electronic payment of council dues.

You go to that web site, choose "Pay Dues", and you are connected to the PayPal system. You must have an active independent PayPal account already set up that is directed either to your check book or a credit card for debit purposes.

You may then pay your dues online for \$41.50 (which includes a \$1.50 electronic processing fee) by using your PayPal account to debit either a stated credit card or an amount directly out of your chosen checking account just like a debit card does. Your personal PayPal account must be set up independently.

You may still pay your normal 2021 annual dues directly at a meeting or send a check made out to "**KofC Council 11402**" to:

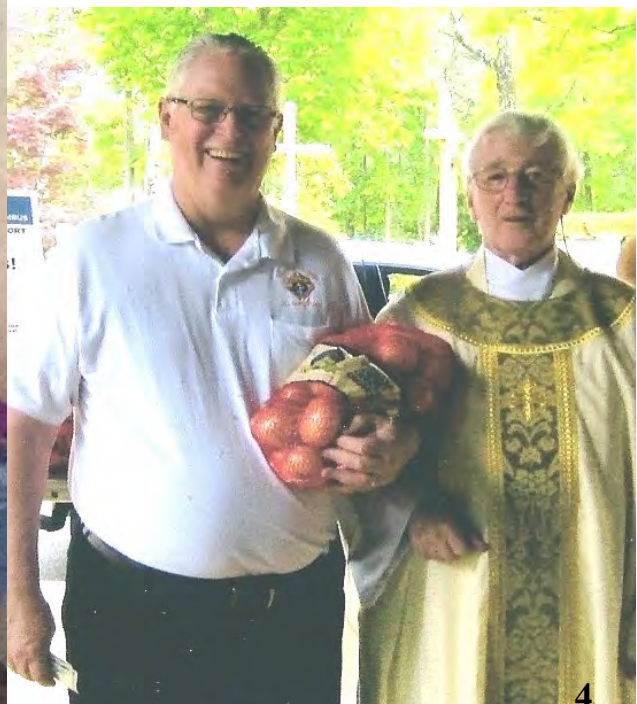
# Vidalia Onion Drive Success

# The Plunkett Press—Eastertide 2021

Brothers,

Thankfully, I was able to return to Benin the end of November, arriving the day before Thanksgiving. It has been good to be back, and I rejoice that Benin (as well as most of Africa) has been spared from the worst cases of COVID-19. Praise God for His mercy on Africa! Please pray for His continued mercies.

My original return ticket was for the end of February. However, as I saw that life here is pretty normal with the low threat of COVID, I quickly decided it would be best to remain here for a much longer stay until life started to return to normal in the U.S. My return ticket is now booked for October 11, 2021.

## Translation Progress

The team has continued to make progress on translation. In March we finished all the corrections to the translation of Genesis 12-25 (the story of Abraham) and we were able to record an audio version of the translation. Daniel, from the SIL Center in Kara, Togo, came over for a week with recording equipment and he set up a make-shift studio in one of the houses in my compound (see photos). We are also working on finishing the corrections of the children's Bible, "God Speaks to His Children".

## Full of Thanksgiving

I am thankful to all of you who support my ministry here in Benin through your prayers and financial gifts. Despite my erratic correspondence, I remain deeply grateful that through you the Lord continues to provide the funds for the translation project (particularly meeting the monthly salaries for the translators and helping with medical expenses for their families) and my needs when I am in Benin. Please continue to pray for the team and myself as we try to get much work done in the five months I have remaining before my flight back to the U.S.

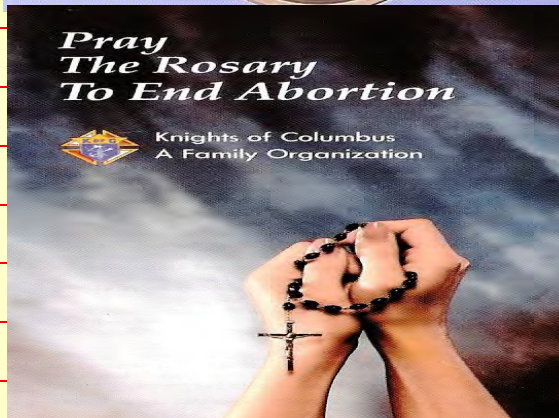

# A. Dennis Caniglia, 77, Has Passed

Nov 8, 1943—May 17, 2021

We got this very sad news that our Sir Knight Alfred Dennis Caniglia passed on Monday May 17<sup>th</sup> due to a heart attack after knee replacement surgery. We only learned of his passing from FaceBook posts. He had no local relatives. His wife, Linda, passed in 2004. They had no children. He was the president of his own insurance litigation company. He is an organ donor and will be interred in our Columbarium.

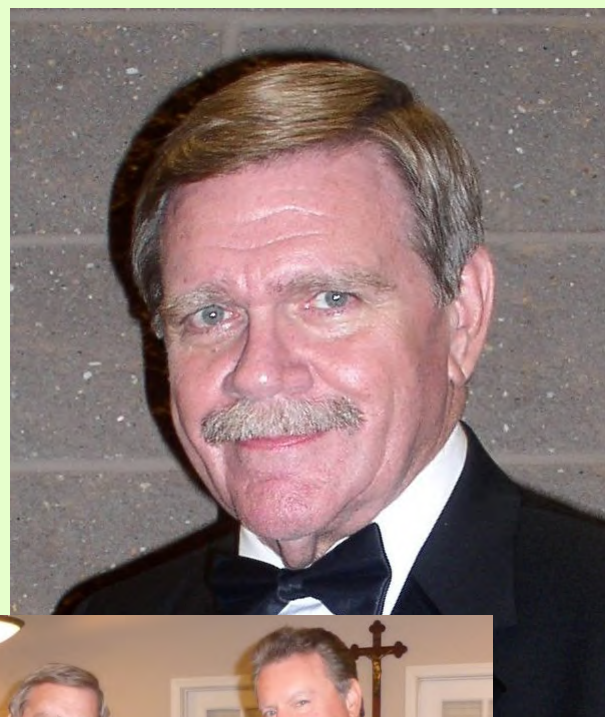

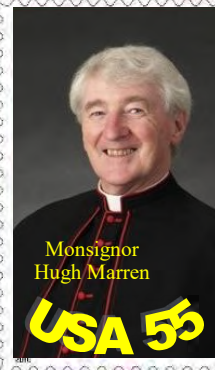
