If you know of someone that might be good at taking on an event or helping out in some other way or might even be interested in a leadership position, please talk to them and connect them to an officer or our Program Director.

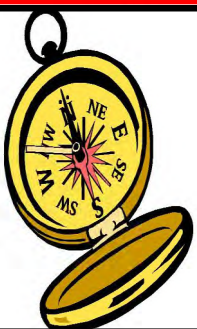

Paying Council Dues Electronically

Members are a little confused as to the proper procedure for paying dues electronically. Sending a check for \$40 by snail mail still works perfectly well also. Those liking immediate gratification may use the instructions below for a small processing fee.

Brothers,

Regular Council 11402 dues for 2021 are \$40.

Our council website www.kc11402.org handles electronic payment of council dues.

You go to that web site, choose "Pay Dues", and you are connected to the PayPal system. You must have an active independent PayPal account already set up that is directed either to your check book or a credit card for debit purposes.

You may then pay your dues online for \$41.50 (which includes a \$1.50 electronic processing fee) by using your PayPal account to debit either a stated credit card or an amount directly out of your chosen checking account just like a debit card does. Your personal PayPal account must be set up independently.

You may still pay your normal 2021 annual dues directly at a meeting or send a check made out to "**KofC Council 11402**" to:

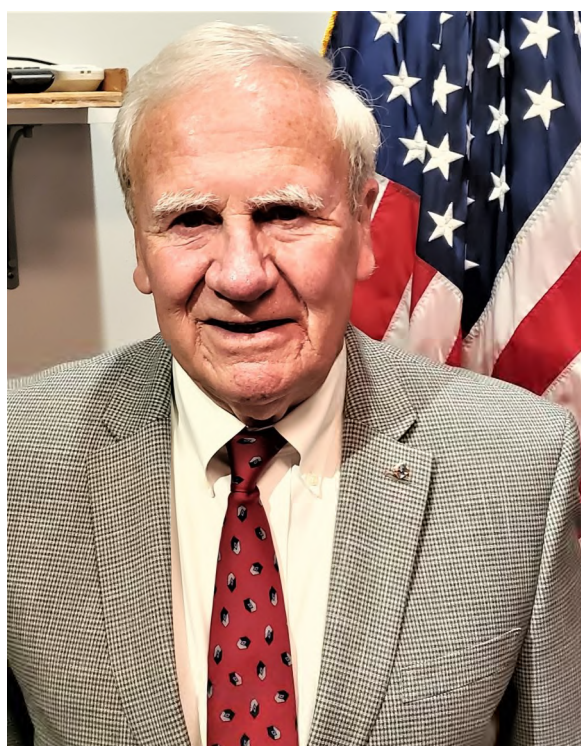

Acolytes Returning in Near Future?

The most unique ministry that all Saints Council has fostered has been our funeral acolyte ministry. We have never heard of another council anywhere which provides Knight acolytes (Mass servers) for all parish funerals.

Teams of three or more brothers have graced the altar during all Parish funerals to assist the priest(s) by carrying crosses, lighted candles, bringing water and wine, furnishing incense and holy water as needed, and carrying cremains if requested. Some funerals then process out to the Columbarium for further devotionals.

Acolytes are divided into teams that take turns covering funerals on weekdays, weekends, and sometimes special occasions like Remembrance Masses. Outfit garb includes navy blue blazers, dark grey dress slacks, white shirt, black shoes and socks, and a special Knight tie given to participants. The funeral cantor usually dresses in a likewise outfit, but does not serve on the altar.

During the Covid pandemic, this ministry was suspended with the need to keep the number of funeral participants at a bare minimum. Now, Monsignor Marren is of a mind to possibly resume this ministry in the next few weeks with three-server Mass maximums. We await official word.

When this ministry resumes, we will need fresh volunteers to replace brothers who have died, moved away to retirement venues, or transferred to other councils. There is not another ministry that serves the council as well and is so visible to the public.

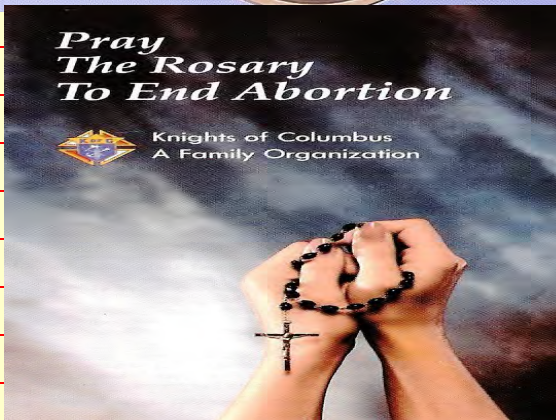

SK Harvey Moskowitz Has Passed

AUGUST 29, 1938 – JULY 15, 2021



Sir Knight Harvey William Moskowitz , 82, passed on July 15, 2021 after a long illness. His private services were held on July 16th at Arlington Memorial Cemetery. He was a veteran and a long time member of the All Saints Council 11402 and a member of the Fr. Charles J. Watters Assembly 2688.

Harvey was born in New York City on August 29, 1938. He is survived by his loving wife of 57 years, Arla, his two brothers, Jay (Joanne) and Edward (Victoria); and a host of nieces, nephews, and cousins.

During life Harvey put together a very impressive resume. He started as a combat pilot for the U.S. Army during the Vietnam era, he was a Fulton County Assistant District Attorney, a Judge in Atlanta Municipal Court, the Director of Atlanta Law School Foundation, a guest speaker at All Saints Parish Mens Club events, an active member of The Knights of Columbus, along with his many career accomplishments and affiliations. He personally bought the parish's figurines for their outdoor Christmas creche.

He was also a man of many hobbies and interests. Harvey was an avid golfer, humanitarian, breeder of thoroughbred horses, and even a farmer of black angus cattle, but his true gift was storytelling. A private funeral service was held Friday, July 16th. In lieu of flowers, please make a donation to a charity of your choosing.

What often goes unnoticed are the significant numbers of children, wives, and widows of the council who passed in 2019, 2020, and 2021. This neared the number of brothers passing.

Now 2021 has started sadly with Ten consecutive member deaths.

Please make it a practice to keep in your prayers, our sick and deceased men and women of Council 11402. Note that all the 2020 deceased members and family were remembered at the State Convention Mass this past May. The 2021 deceased people will be remembered next year at the GA Convention.

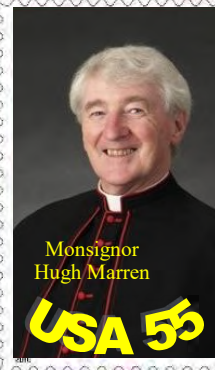
