Paying Council Dues Electronically

Members are a little confused as to the proper procedure for paying dues electronically. Sending a check for \$40 by snail mail still works perfectly well also. Those liking immediate gratification may use the instructions below for a small processing fee.

Regular Council 11402 dues for 2021 are \$40.

Our council website <u>www.kc11402.org</u> handles electronic payment of council dues.

You go to that web site, choose "Pay Dues", and you are connected to the PayPal system. You must have an active independent PayPal account already set up that is directed either to your check book or a credit card for debit purposes.

You may then pay your dues online for \$41.50 (which includes a \$1.50 electronic processing fee) by using your PayPal account to debit either a stated credit card or an amount directly out of your chosen checking account just like a debit card does. Your personal PayPal account must be set up independently.

On Saturday night, August 7th, the Charles J. Watters Fourth Degree Assembly of Knights and relatives were treated to reduced rate tickets at a Gwinnett Stripers minor league baseball game at Coolray Field in Lawrenceville. The food was hot and the right field suite was spacious, but the weather did not cooperate. The game was called after a deluge right after proposed start time. Having a good time under the enclosed area, no one was in a hurry to rush home. Tickets will be valid for a future home game.

The Gwinnett Stripers, formally called the Gwinnett Braves, are the high triple AAA affiliate of the Braves organization and play great ball. Many of the players will move up to the Braves when rosters are expanded near season end. Coolray Field is a wonderful smaller scale ball park with easy access. You should consider attending minor league games as cheaper and more convenient. Seats are readily available to any game.





Acolytes Returning in Near Future?

The most unique ministry that all Saints Council has fostered has been our funeral acolyte ministry. We have never heard of another council anywhere which provides Knight acolytes (Mass servers) for all parish funerals.

Teams of three or more brothers have graced the altar during all Parish funerals to assist the priest(s) by carrying crosses, lighted candles, bringing water and wine, furnishing incense and holy water as needed, and carrying cremains if requested. Some funerals then process out to the Columbarium for further devotionals.

Acolytes are divided into teams that take turns covering funerals on weekdays, weekends, and sometimes special occasions like Remembrance Masses. Outfit garb includes navy blue blazers, dark grey dress slacks, white shirt, black shoes and socks, and a special Knight tie given to participants. The funeral cantor usually dresses in a likewise outfit, but does not serve on the altar.

During the Covid pandemic, this ministry was suspended with the need to keep the number of funeral participants at a bare minimum. Now, Monsignor Marren is of a mind to possibly resume this ministry in the next few weeks with three-server Mass acolytes maximums. We await official word.

When this ministry resumes, we will need fresh volunteers to replace brothers who have died, moved away to retirement venues, or transferred to other councils. There is not another ministry that serves the council as well and is so visible to the public.



Sir Knight Joe Kane Has Passed

Joseph John Kane

NOVEMBER 20, 1936 - AUGUST 18, 2021



Joseph "Joe" John Kane passed away Wednesday August 18, 2021 in Atlanta, GA at the age of 84.

He was born November 20, 1936 in Washington, D.C. to William and Mae Agnes Kane. Joe graduated from Georgetown in 1958 and joined the Army as an Artillery Officer 1959-1961. Following his military service, he wrote for TIME magazine and contributed to 19 TIME cover stories and was Bureau Chief in several US cities until his retirement in 1991. He was known for his passion for interviewing and learning, as well as his humor and sharp wit.

Mr. Kane married Judith Chapman in 1963, and together they had four sons. He was devout in his faith in the Lord and was a very active member at his church and with the Knights of Columbus.

He is survived by his wife of 57 years, Judith Jean Kane of Atlanta, GA; four sons, Christopher Thomas of Seattle, WA, Gregory Marquis, Joseph Timothy and Jason Philip of Atlanta, GA; grandchildren, Shannon Marie, Melissa Anne, Kristen Judith, and Jonathon Joseph; great-grandchildren, Sofia and Vivian; one brother, William Kane of Bethesda, MD; and three sisters, Bernadette Mitchell of Palm Desert, CA, Mary Ellen McAuliffe Keily of Bethany Beach, DE, and Elizabeth Rogers of Wheaton, MD. He was preceded in death by brothers, Eugene I. Kane of Potomac, MD and Monsignor Thomas A. Kane of Annapolis, MD.

Now 2021 has started sadly with Eleven consecutive member deaths.


