It would be great to have as many of you attend the January 4th business meeting as possible, as we try to rebuild all we do from the events of the last couple years.

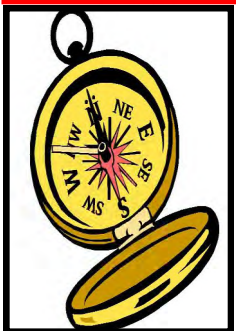

Paying Council Dues Electronically

Members are a little confused as to the proper procedure for paying dues electronically. Sending a check for \$40 by snail mail still works perfectly well also. Those liking immediate gratification may use the instructions below for a small processing fee.

Brothers,

Regular Council 11402 dues for 2021 are \$40.

Our council website www.kc11402.org handles electronic payment of council dues.

You go to that web site, choose "Pay Dues", and you are connected to the PayPal system. You must have an active independent PayPal account already set up that is directed either to your check book or a credit card for debit purposes.

You may then pay your dues online for \$41.75 (which includes a \$1.75 electronic processing fee) by using your PayPal account to debit either a stated credit card or an amount directly out of your chosen checking account just like a debit card does. Your personal PayPal account must be set up independently.

You may still pay your normal 2021 annual dues directly at a meeting or send a check made out to "**KofC Council 11402**" to:

Council Installs Parish Creche

As we do every year, All Saints Council installed our venerable Christmas creche just before Christmas. This year, the parish requested that it be installed in the gym rather than outdoors. We obliged, although the creche is designed as an outdoor unit. It was installed on December 20th by eight brothers.

Years ago, our past Grand Knight, Greg Crnkovich, designed and built the wooden exterior shell, while Sir Knight Harvey Moskowitz purchased the large clay figurines from his own pocket. (Sadly, Harvey passed away this year). Now showing its age, the Council has constantly made some creche enhancements and repairs over the years.

We later learned that it had to be dismantled the day after Christmas, December 26th, to enable the gym floor to be re-stained. Usually creches stay up until the Feast of the Three Kings (Epiphany), this year early on January 2nd. Before and after pictures are shown below.

I CARE - Volunteer Drivers for Seniors of DeKalb County:

I CARE is a 501 (C3) Non-Profit organization, based in Decatur, Georgia, and located at 735 Sycamore Drive, Decatur, GA 30030 (at the “Church at Decatur Heights”).

I CARE matches Volunteer Drivers with DeKalb County Senior Citizens (including seniors with disabilities) who, for financial and medical reasons, have no other means of transportation to medical appointments, Rx pickup and Free grocery pickup and delivery.

Volunteer drivers use their own vehicles to provide the FREE Door to Door transportation to Seniors. Volunteers share themselves through not only their time and service, but also through their companionship. Rides are provided weekdays, between 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM.

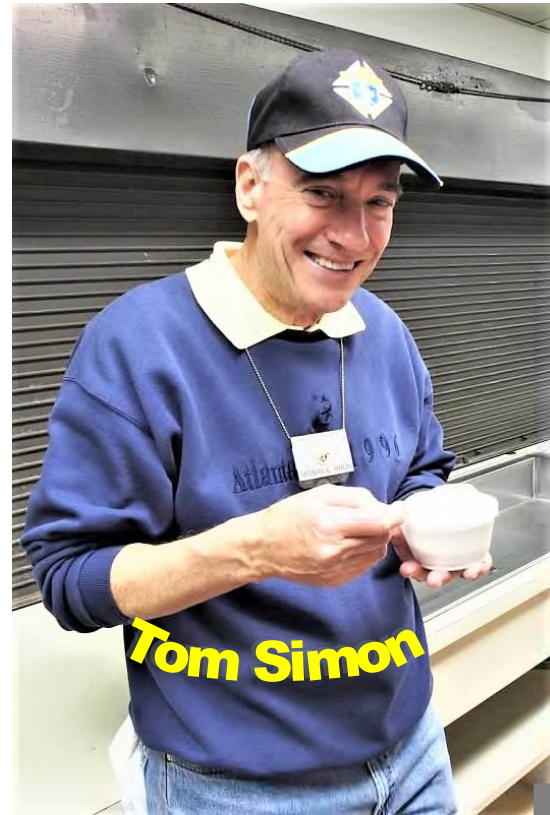

In Memoriam

As we delve into the 2022 year, we remember the extraordinary number of All Saints brothers who have passed since the 2019 holiday season. We've lost **29** brothers since the year-end 2019 holiday season. We also lost 22 family members in three years.

In 2019, we almost made it through the entire year without the death of a council brother. Then, we had three consecutive holiday deaths just before the end of 2019.

In 2020, we were not so fortunate. All Saints lost a total of nine brothers, setting a sad yearly record for the council since its founding in 1994. Now 2021 has far exceeded that sad record.

What often goes unnoticed are the significant numbers of children, wives, and widows of the council who passed in 2019, 2020, and 2021. This neared the number of brothers passing.

Now 2021 has ended sadly with Seventeen consecutive member deaths.

Please make it a practice to keep in your prayers, our sick and deceased men and women of Council 11402. Note that all the 2020 deceased members and family were remembered at the State Convention Mass this past May. The 2021 deceased people will be remembered next year at the GA State Convention.

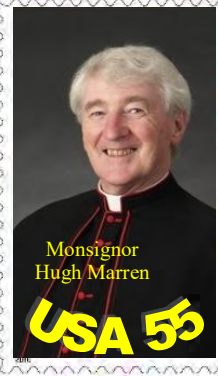
