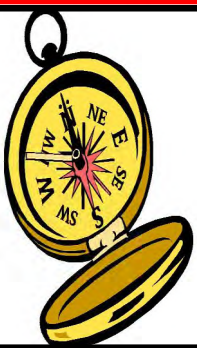

Paying Council Dues Electronically

Members are a little confused as to the proper procedure for paying dues electronically. Sending a check for \$40 by snail mail or paying at a council meeting still works perfectly well also. Those liking immediate gratification may use the instructions below for a small processing fee.

Brothers,

Regular Council 11402 dues for 2022 are \$40.

Our council website www.kc11402.org handles electronic payment of council dues as well.

You go to that web site, choose "Pay Dues", and you are connected to the PayPal system. You must have an active independent PayPal account already set up that is directed either to your check book or a credit card for debit purposes.

You may then pay your dues online for \$41.75 (which includes a \$1.75 electronic processing fee) by using your PayPal account to debit either a stated credit card or an amount directly out of your chosen checking account just like a debit card does. Your personal PayPal account must be set up independently at web site Paypal.com.

You may still pay your normal 2022 annual dues directly at a meeting or send a \$40 check made out to "**KofC Council 11402**" to:

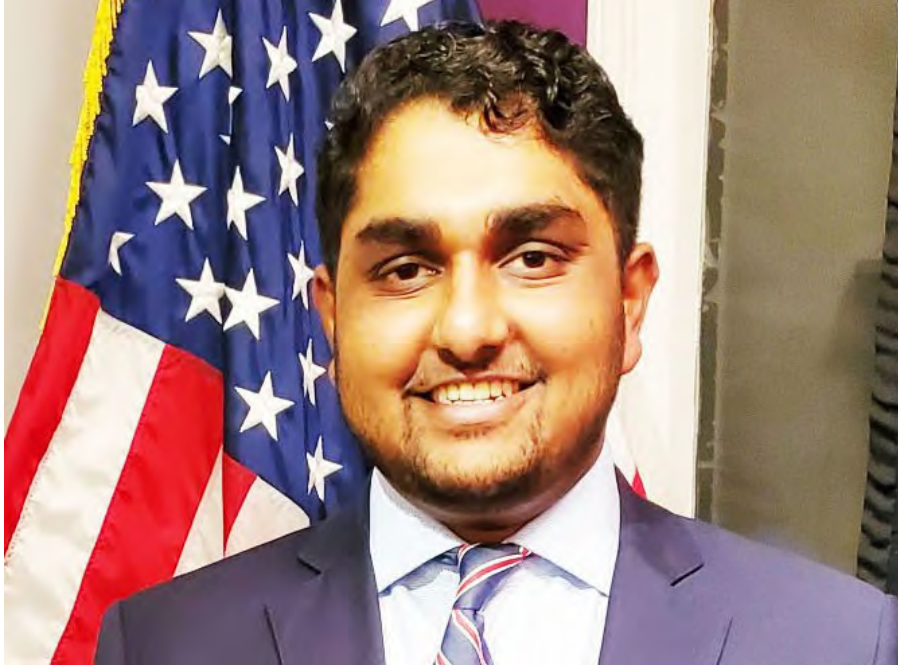

Assembly Chalice Presentaion

On September 12th at the All Saints 9 AM Mass, our Father Charles J. Watters fourth degree Assembly 2688 presented their 23rd Chalice and Paten Kit to a priest in need. The recipient was Father Balappa Selvaraj for use by his associate priests of the Little Way Messenger Charity in India. Our Assembly consists of Sir Knights from All Saints, Mary Our Queen, and St. Andrew Councils. Sir Knights Nick Mattera, Woody Jones, and Ed Pierson did the honors. All Saints widow Andi Berrigan was present because deceased Sir Knight Stephen Berrigan was honored on this chalice. Also honored were Dennis Caniglia and William Clough of Good Shepard.



Deceased Brother Chalice Remembrances

With all the disturbing news regarding our deceased brothers in the last few years, we note that our 4th degree Sir Knights have not been forgotten. Our Fr. Charles J. Watters Assembly remembers all deceased Sir Knights on engraved chalices given to new priests. The Assembly has now purchased over two dozen chalice and paten kits over the years and now has a total of 26 of such chalice remembrances ongoing.

Chalices have traditionally been presented to diocesan priests, but most families purchase chalices for their own new priests. The Assembly has moved to awarding new chalices to deserving new priests in foreign lands. Three deceased Sir Knight names grace each chalice, and they are all remembered in each Mass said by the recipient. Chalice # 23 was presented on Sept. 12th after the All Saints 9 AM Mass. Chalices #24 and #25 are not yet assigned. The death of Gregory Kane has necessitated a Chalice #26. Chalices are another good reason to become a Sir Knight.

Future Chalice Report — (Chalice #23 Presented (Chalices #24, #25 Filled)

Monsignor Marren put us in touch with a nurse, Ide Maya of Catholic World Missions, who knew of chalice needs in the Congo. We sent two chalices off to her in that country. Chalices #20 and #21 are now presented. Chalice #22 was presented to Msgr. Simon Assamese for a priest in Ghana, Fr. Prince Oti Ayeh, pictures were shown in Minutes.

Decedent names were later rearranged to ensure that Wiley Maloof, son Marion Maloof, and dear friend of theirs, Deacon Ed Krise, were all listed on the same chalice #22 together

Chalice #23 is now assigned to Fr. Selvaraj of India for Little Way Messenger priests to use.

In late 2021, the passing of Harvey Moskowitz, Joseph Kane, and Deacon Ray Egan necessitated the planning for chalice #24. Now Chalice #25 is filled with the passing of Schaaf, Stinson, and Klapka. Both chalice #24 and #25 are not yet assigned. Gregory Kane's death necessitated #26.

In Memoriam

Judith Jean (Chapman) Kane
(1939 – 2022)

Judith “Judy” Jean (Chapman) Kane passed away Friday, September 2, 2022 in Roswell, GA at the age of 83. She was born February 18, 1939 in Chicago, Illinois to Bertram and Helen Chapman, the eldest of three children.

Judy met the love of her life, Joseph Kane, while they both were working at TIME Magazine, and they were married in 1963 in Scarsdale, NY. Over the next two decades, Judy and Joe found themselves moving frequently around the United States - a result of Joe’s work. From Miami to Atlanta (or “Atlanta One,” as the family referred to it as), to Northern Virginia, then onto Los Angeles, before eventually settling back in Atlanta (“Atlanta Two”) in 1985.

Judy was devout in her Catholic faith, involved in programs at her church and charitable activities in her community. Judy was an active member of the Dunwoody Woman’s Club for many years, and she enjoyed representing their Conservation Program at holiday toy drives and events in support of schools, teachers, and community first responders.

Judy is survived by her four sons, Christopher Thomas (and Susan) of Seattle, WA; Gregory Marquis, Joseph Timothy, and Jason Philip of Atlanta, GA; grandchildren Shannon Marie, Melissa Anne, Kristen Judith, and Jonathon Joseph; great-grandchildren Sofia Rose and Vivian Kane; her brother Douglas M. of Albuquerque, NM.

She was preceded in death by her husband of nearly 60 years, Joseph John Kane just one year prior, as well as her sister Martha Jane Chapman and her parents, Bertram and Helen.

Gregory Marquis KANE, age 55, of Dunwoody, Georgia passed away on Thursday, September 15, 2022. Gregory was born November 12, 1966.

No detailed obituary is yet located. Greg was a fourth degree Sir Knight. He passed a few weeks after his mother above.

We announced the death of John (Jack) Klapka in the last newsletter and showed a picture of his funeral honor guard. At that time there was no detailed obituary appearing on the Internet. We include this article showing what a unique individual that he was.

John "Jack" Klapka

Born in 1938, John "Jack" Klapka passed away on Thursday July 21st 2022 at the age of 83. He is survived by his devoted wife Maralind and his children David (Jennifer) and Tiffany (Robert Brannan) and 2 grandchildren who reside in Cumming Georgia. His 38 year career at IBM eventually relocated the family to Sandy Springs, GA.



Jack was also an 8 year veteran of the Naval Reserves where he was honorably discharged with dedicated service as a MAD Sonar Operator aboard a P-2 Neptune. After retirement from IBM, he then began a Real Estate career with Prudential Atlanta Realty and retired after an amazing 12 year career filled with milestones, awards and records. Jack was also an active member of the Knights of Columbus achieving 4th degree status, during his 65 year membership. He and Maralind were also active members of Marriage Encounter and were admirable mentors to newly wed couples on retreats and also strengthening their marriage on an ongoing basis and were a shining example of a loving and devoted couple. They just celebrated 55 wonderful years of marriage. Jack had a great approach to life and it made him not only successful in careers but also in his friendships. 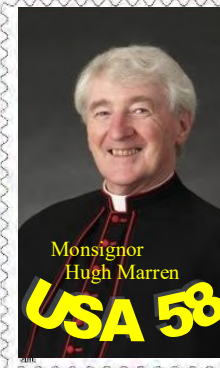
