You can skip the lines at the regular sale day and make your wife HAPPY! (She loves onions.)

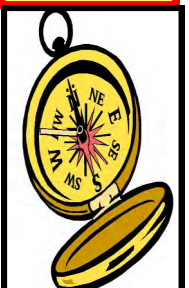

Paying Council Dues Electronically

Members are a little confused as to proper procedures for paying dues electronically. Sending a check for \$40 by snail mail works, Paying \$40 at a council meeting by cash, check, or by our “Square” credit card reader device works perfectly well also.

Those liking immediate remote gratification may use the instructions below. We no longer use PayPal. Now **Zelle** is the proper app to send \$40 electronically without fee. Our website can also handle credit cards electronically for \$41.50 (\$1.50 process fee).

Regular Council 11402 dues for 2023 are \$40.

Our council website www.kc11402.org handles electronic payment of council dues by credit card as well.

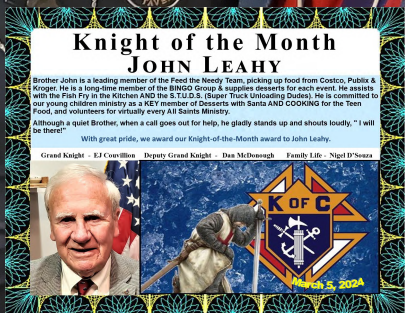

Fourth of July Trailer Renovation

My project will remove the existing boards off the trailer, remove the wheels, remove the original metal fasteners, and use a steel brush to wipe off all of the loose rust.

Afterwards, my project will coat the trailer in rust converter.

Next, we will coat the trailer in primer and paint the metal frame. We must then check if the lights and the wheels work and if they are safe.

Then, my project will attach wooden boards on each side of the metal frame to create a sandwich that will pinch the metal frame.

Next, we will then screw deck boards on top of the wooden framing boards with wooden screws into the pinched wooden boards.

My project will attach a perpendicular board onto the edge of the boards, and lastly coat the wood in a stain.

The Knights do not yet have a plan for any float on top of the trailer, so my project does not need to do that.

Vidalia Onion Sale Update

This year again, All Saints Council will be ordering an 18-wheeler truck with about 2,000 ten-pound bags of Vidalia Onions from (where else ? Vidalia Georgia).

Onion responses from our other participating Churches and Order Amounts should be finalized by April 1 (No Fools!). Basically the same churches are participating plus the Dawsonville Council added this year.

Sir Knights Dean Trantow (Big Onion), Dick Marklein, and Willie Trent. are running the show.



We have recommended the All Saints Order amount to be around 200 bags, up from 155 last year.

Our selling price at All Saints is recommended to be \$13.00 per ten-pound bag, up from \$12.50/bag last year. Expecting some slight inflationary costs vs. 2023.

Recommended All Saints Onion Sales weekend to be April 27 - 28, and Dean will confirm with Jessica. Alternate weekend date would be May 4-5. (Mothers' Day is 5/12).

Expected Onion Truck delivery on/around Thursday or Friday (5/25-26) and we'll coordinate the other church's pickup around those dates.

Council Eyewear Recycling



Our brother Paul McNulty volunteers for the GA Lighthouse Association to recycle used eyewear of all types to that organization.

He will position a donation box in the knights hall to collect these items rather than throwing them away.

His message is below. Please bring old used eyewear and deposit it for recycling when you come to council meetings.

All eyewear goes through a three-step QA process and those that can be re-used (approx. 70%) are donated to mission groups that travel throughout the world providing glasses to the needy.

The glasses and pieces of eyewear that come in damaged, are then sent to a recycler for which GA Lighthouse receives monies to help operate their free eye testing clinic, which is staffed with a licensed volunteer Optometrist at the Chamblee clinic. As a part of this, clients can receive not only free testing but very low price or free glasses. if they qualify based on income.

They collect **Sun, Prescription, and Reading glasses and know that many of us have multiple pairs of glasses that we no longer need. We either throw them away or keep them in a drawer.**

We would like to ask, that the Brothers bring any unneeded eyewear to the December 5th council meeting, and we will provide a donation box and bring them to GA Lighthouse to help others in need of glasses.

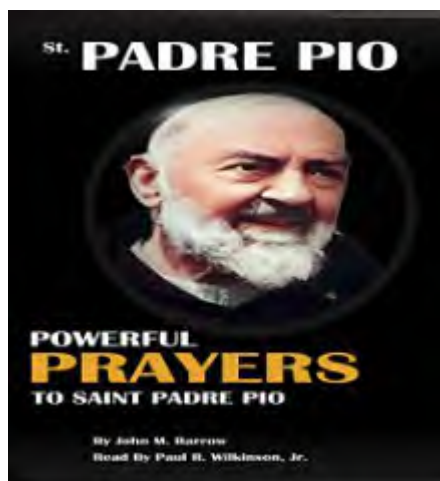

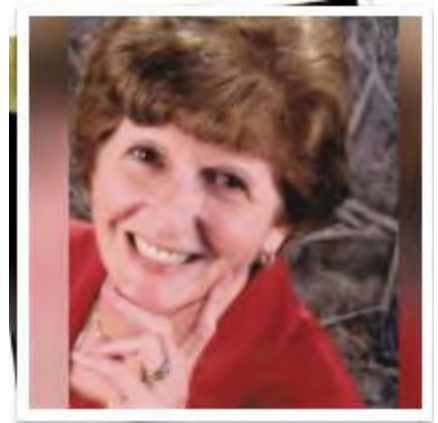
