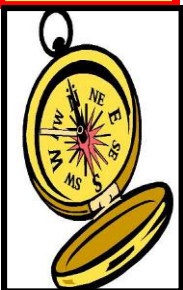
CAN WE COUNT ON YOU?

Paying Council Dues Electronically

Members are a little confused as to proper procedures for paying dues electronically. Sending a check for \$40 by snail mail works, Paying \$40 at a council meeting by cash, check, or by our “Square” credit card reader device works perfectly well also.

Those liking immediate remote gratification may use the instructions below. We no longer use PayPal. Now **Zelle** is the proper app to send \$40 electronically without fee. Our website can also handle credit cards electronically for \$41.50 (\$1.50 process fee).

Regular Council 11402 dues for 2023 are \$40.

Our council website www.kc11402.org handles electronic payment of council dues by credit card as well.

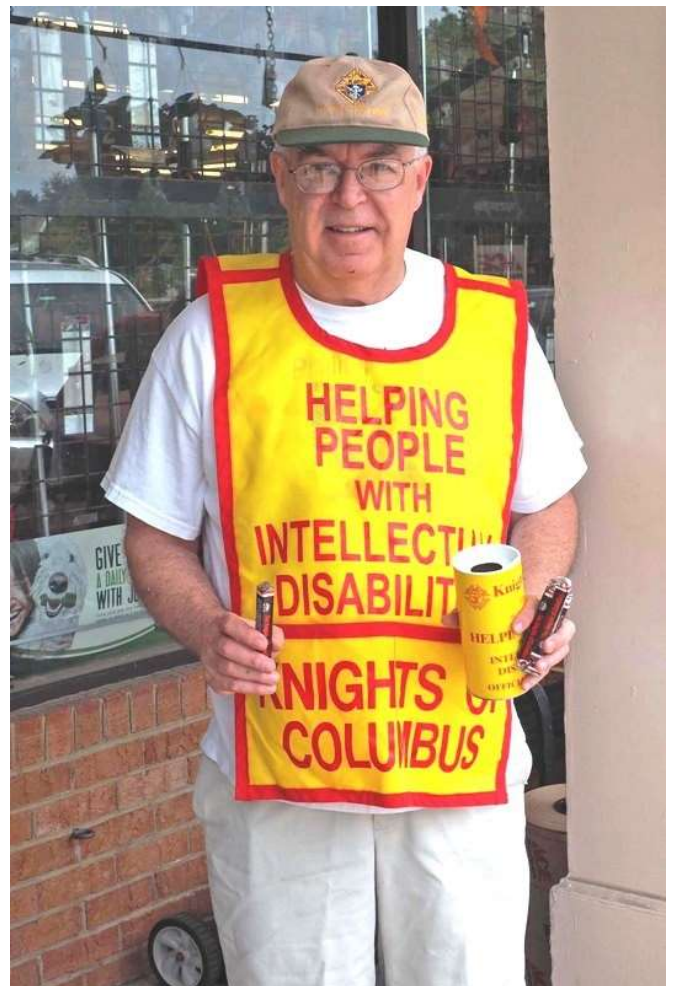

Our Sir Knight Bryan Kler's son Owen is pursuing the Eagle Scout Rank and has asked the Council's help. His project is to rebuild our dilapidated trailer used to carry a float in the Dunwoody Independence Day Parade.

The Council will consider partially funding this project. The Scouts require multiple funding sources. This project, if completed, will spur our council to build and enter a float in this year's parade (which is our Council's exact 30th birthday. We were founded on July 4th, 1994.

Fourth of July Trailer Renovation

My project will remove the existing boards off the trailer, remove the wheels, remove the original metal fasteners, and use a steel brush to wipe off all of the loose rust.

Afterwards, my project will coat the trailer in rust converter.

Next, we will coat the trailer in primer and paint the metal frame. We must then check if the lights and the wheels work and if they are safe.

Then, my project will attach wooden boards on each side of the metal frame to create a sandwich that will pinch the metal frame.

Next, we will then screw deck boards on top of the wooden framing boards with wooden screws into the pinched wooden boards.

My project will attach a perpendicular board onto the edge of the boards, and lastly coat the wood in a stain.

The Knights do not yet have a plan for any float on top of the trailer, so my project does not need to do that.

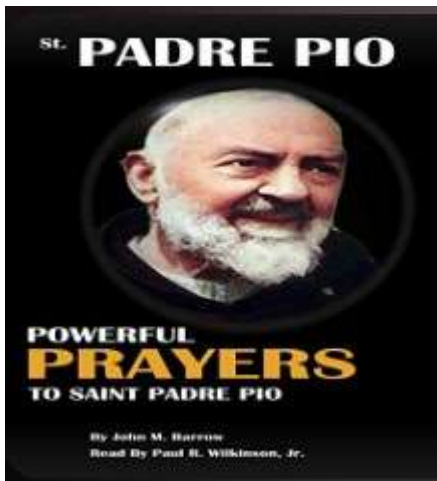

Watters Assembly honors all deceased Sir Knights on engraved chalices given to new priests. 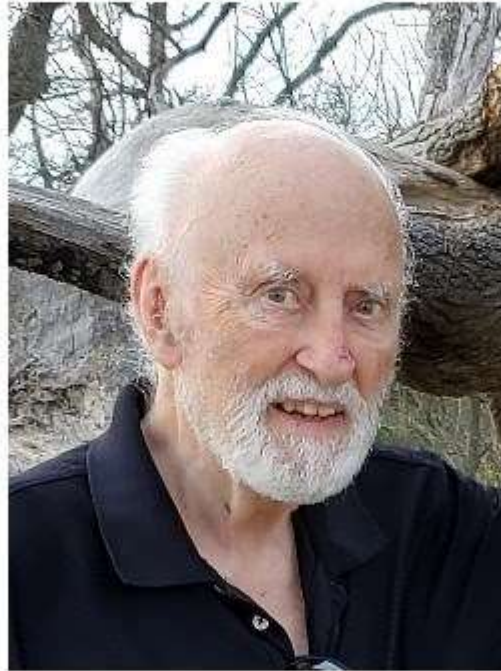
