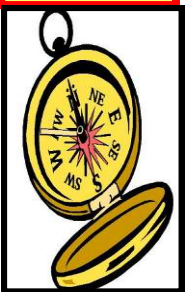

Paying Council Dues Electronically

Members are a little confused as to proper procedures for paying dues electronically. Sending a check for \$40 by snail mail works, Paying \$40 at a council meeting by cash, check, or by our “Square” credit card reader device works perfectly well also.

Those liking immediate remote gratification may use the instructions below. We no longer use PayPal. Now **Zelle** is the proper app to send \$40 electronically without fee. Our website can also handle credit cards electronically for \$41.50 (\$1.50 process fee).

Regular Council 11402 dues for 2023 are \$40.

Our council website www.kc11402.org handles electronic payment of council dues by credit card as well.

Without the need to login, you go to that website above, choose “Pay Dues”, and then you have the ability to:

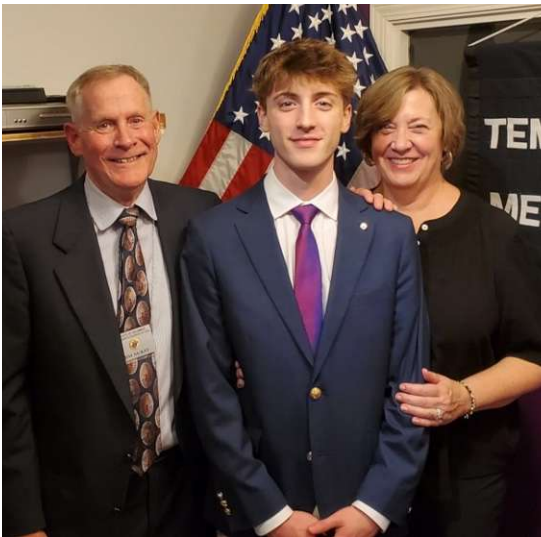


Jim McKay Recruiting Award

All Saints Has 14 New Saints

It was a big crowd for a Friday evening Solemn High Mass on November 1st (All Saints Day). One big attraction was the unveiling of the 14 portraits of saints that are now hanging where the 14 Stations of the Cross (7 on each side) formerly hung. The Stations will be relocated and possibly replaced on a lower level soon.

The saints chosen for display were the result of a parish vote taken during the Summer. All depictions are artist renderings, since polaroids of early saints are difficult to obtain. There are obviously many popular or worthy saints overlooked, but there is more vacant wall room left in the rear of the church.

The saints shown (starting on Our Lady's side, closest to the altar: St. Patrick, St. Maxmillian Kolbe, St. Therese of Lisieux, St. John Paul, St. Faustina, St. Juan Diego, St. Josephine Bakhita, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Monica, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Teresa of Calcutta, St. Padre Pio, St. Joan of Arc, St. Thomas Aquinas.

Note that St. Peter, St. Jude, and St. Michael were high in the vote count, but were replaced because the artist that we chose did not have portraits of them that Father Silloway and his team liked. They will certainly be included in future sacred art projects!

Ten Homeless Shelter Dates Need Volunteers

For many years, Council 11402 has participated in the All Saints Parish Homeless Shelter Management Program at the Bashor Homeless Mens Shelter co-located at the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception Church and the adjacent Central Presbyterian Church. Only a gate separates the two properties and teams split between the two church facilities. The Shrine is located at 201 Washington Street SW, Atlanta 30303 downtown.

The Bashor Homeless Mens Shelter is a non-profit organization started in 1980 by an ecumenical group concerned about the growing problem of homelessness in Atlanta.

As a ministry of hospitality, it has evolved into a winter night shelter serving the needs of 90-100 homeless men in downtown Atlanta from November 1 through March 31. Open seven nights a week, the shelter provides guests with a hot meal, bagged lunch, and breakfast; showers; access to medical and foot care; and recreational activities such as yoga, basketball, and art.

Usually parish women donate, cook, and deliver meals to the shelter and then leave. The men make bag lunches, serve full evening meals, manage the homeless, sleep overnight, and provide morning bag lunches as the homeless depart.

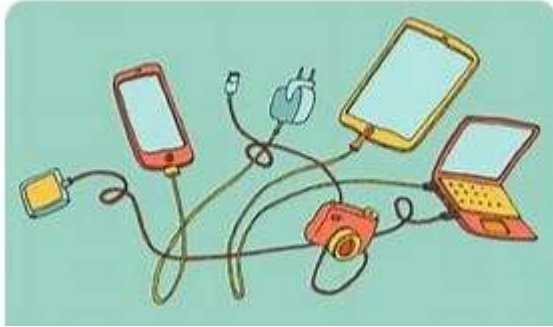

Council Eyewear Recycling



Our brother Paul McNulty volunteers for the GA Lighthouse Association to recycle used eyewear of all types to that organization.

He will position a donation box in the knights hall to collect these items rather than throwing them away.

His message is below. Please bring old used eyewear and deposit it for recycling when you come to council meetings.

All eyewear goes through a three-step QA process and those that can be re-used (approx. 70%) are donated to mission groups that travel throughout the world providing glasses to the needy.

The glasses and pieces of eyewear that come in damaged, are then sent to a recycler for which GA Lighthouse receives monies to help operate their free eye testing clinic, which is staffed with a licensed volunteer Optometrist at the Chamblee clinic. As a part of this, clients can receive not only free testing but very low price or free glasses. if they qualify based on income.

They collect **Sun, Prescription, and Reading glasses** and know that many of us have multiple pairs of glasses that we no longer need. We either throw them away or keep them in a drawer.

We would like to ask, that the Brothers bring any unneeded eyewear to each & every council meeting, and we will provide a donation box and bring them to GA Lighthouse to help others in need of glasses.

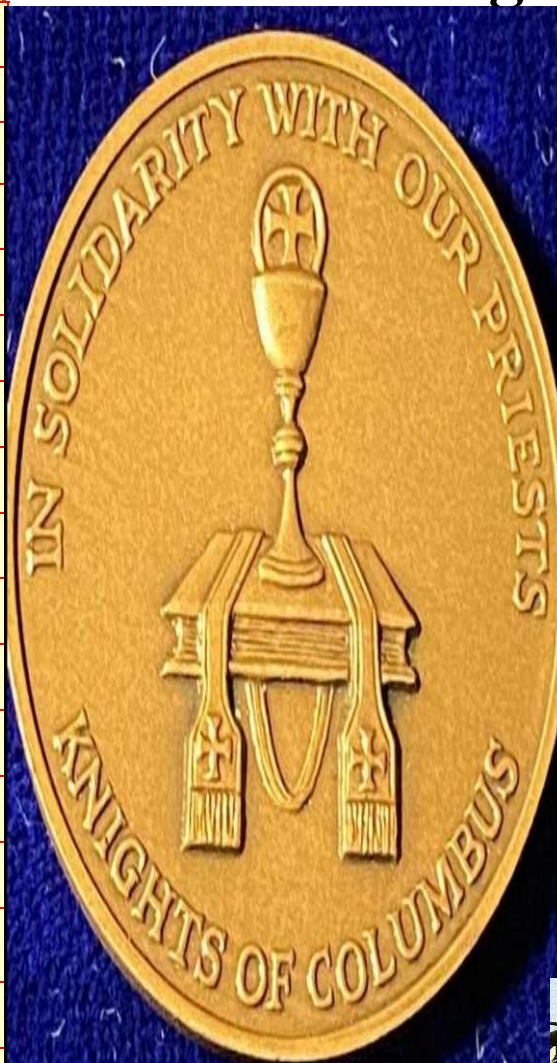

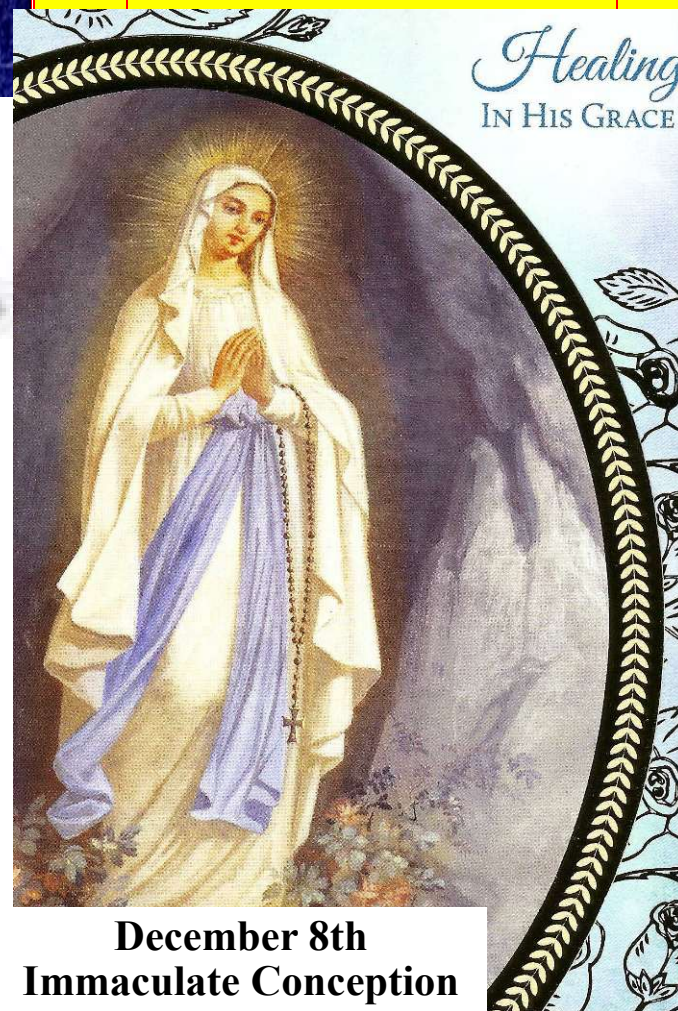

Deceased Sir Knight Chalice Remembrances

With all the sad news regarding deceased brothers in the last few years, our fourth degree Sir Knights are specially remembered. Our **Fr. Charles J. Watters Assembly** honors all deceased Sir Knights from our three member councils on engraved chalices given to new priests. The Watters Assembly has now purchased dozens of such chalice and paten kits to be awarded. Deceased Sir Knights from All Saints, Mary Our Queen, and St. Andrew Councils are memorialized.

Chalices have traditionally been awarded to local diocesan priests, but most families purchase a chalice for their own as an ordination present.
