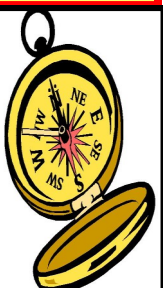
- **Father Michael McGivney Award** which is achieved by recruiting 15 new members to Council 11402.

Paying Council Dues Electronically

Members are a little confused as to proper procedures for paying dues electronically. Sending a check for \$40 by snail mail works, Paying \$40 at a council meeting by cash, check, or by our “Square” credit card reader device works perfectly well also.

Those liking immediate remote gratification may use the instructions below. We no longer use PayPal. Now **Zelle** is the proper app to send \$40 electronically without fee. Our website can also handle credit cards electronically for \$41.50 (\$1.50 process fee).

Regular Council 11402 dues for 2025 are \$40.

Our council website www.kc11402.org handles electronic payment of council dues by credit card as well.

Without the need to login, you go to that website above, choose “Pay Dues”, and then you have the ability to:

Archbishop Hartmeyer announces 2025 Priest reassignments effective July 1, 2025, These are past and present clergy of our council who are moving or in the news.

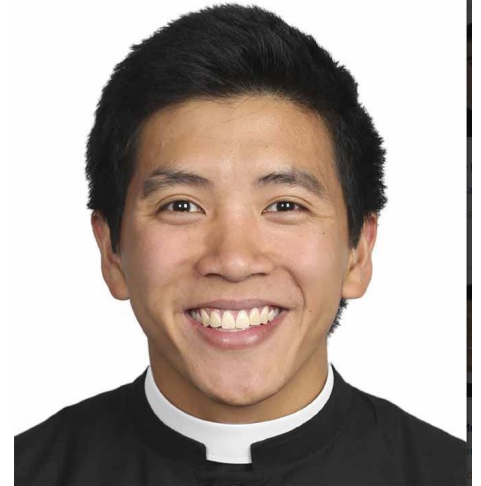

All Saints New Parochial Vicar

With the July 1, 2025 transfer of Fr. Tan Pham, Fr. Baffour of Ghana replaces him.

Rev. Fr. Anthony Baffour Awuah was born at Obuasi in Ghana. He had his elementary education in Obuasi and secondary education at the St. Hubert Minor Seminary in Kumasi, all in Ghana. He had his Major Seminary formation at St. Paul Major Seminary - Accra and St. Peter Regional Seminary - Cape Coast, all in Ghana. He was ordained a priest on 7th December 2002 and was incardinated into the Catholic Diocese of Obuasi.

From 2002 to 2012, he worked as the Parochial Vicar at St. Anthony Catholic Church – Manso, and St. Thomas Cathedral – Obuasi. He was the Diocesan Youth Chaplain from 2004 to 2011. He was in Rome to study Masters in Religious Education at the Pontifical Salesians University from 2011 to 2014.

- **a board member of the following Schools; St. Joseph Catholic Technical and Senior High School – Ahwereni, Christ the King Catholic Senior High School – Obuasi, and the Presentation of Our Lady Girls School Complex – Obuasi.**

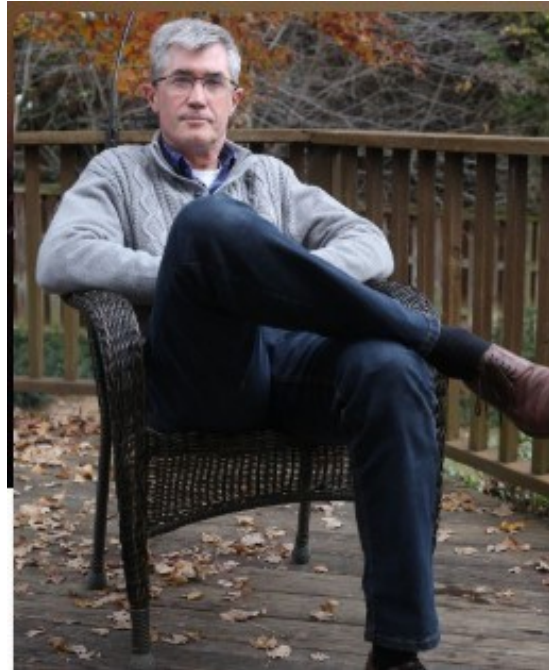

Council Eyewear Recycling



Our brother Paul McNulty volunteers for the GA Lighthouse Association to recycle used eyewear of all types to them. He has positioned a donation box in our Knights Hall and church locations to collect them rather than throwing them away. Please bring old used eyewear and deposit it for recycling when you come to a council meeting.

All eyewear goes through a three-step Q&A process, and those that can be reused (70%) are donated to mission groups that travel the world providing glasses to the needy.

The glasses and pieces of eyewear that come in damaged, are then sent to a recycler for which the GA Lighthouse receives monies the help operate their free eye testing clinic. Clients can receive not only free testing, but very low prices or free glasses depending upon income.

We collect **Sun, Prescription, and Reading glasses. Many of us have multiple pairs of glasses no longer needed. We either throw them away or stick them in a forgotten drawer. Bring them instead to the council meetings for transfer to the GA Lighthouse Association.**



Note from Paul: “Last night we picked up the full container of donated used eyewear from our Brothers, and wish to say Thank You for their donations of 140 pairs of glasses to date. This has brought the total donations, including parish wide and SVDP collections, to a total of 1,116 pairs of eyewear over the past 15 months.

These donations make it possible for those less fortunate throughout the World, to have improved eyesite. The Ga Lighthouse continues to send, on average, 8-10,000 pairs of glasses each month to mission groups traveling the world seeking to help those in need of glasses. Plus they operate a free/low cost clinic, to help improve sight of those less fortunate that qualify for the program at their Chamblee location.

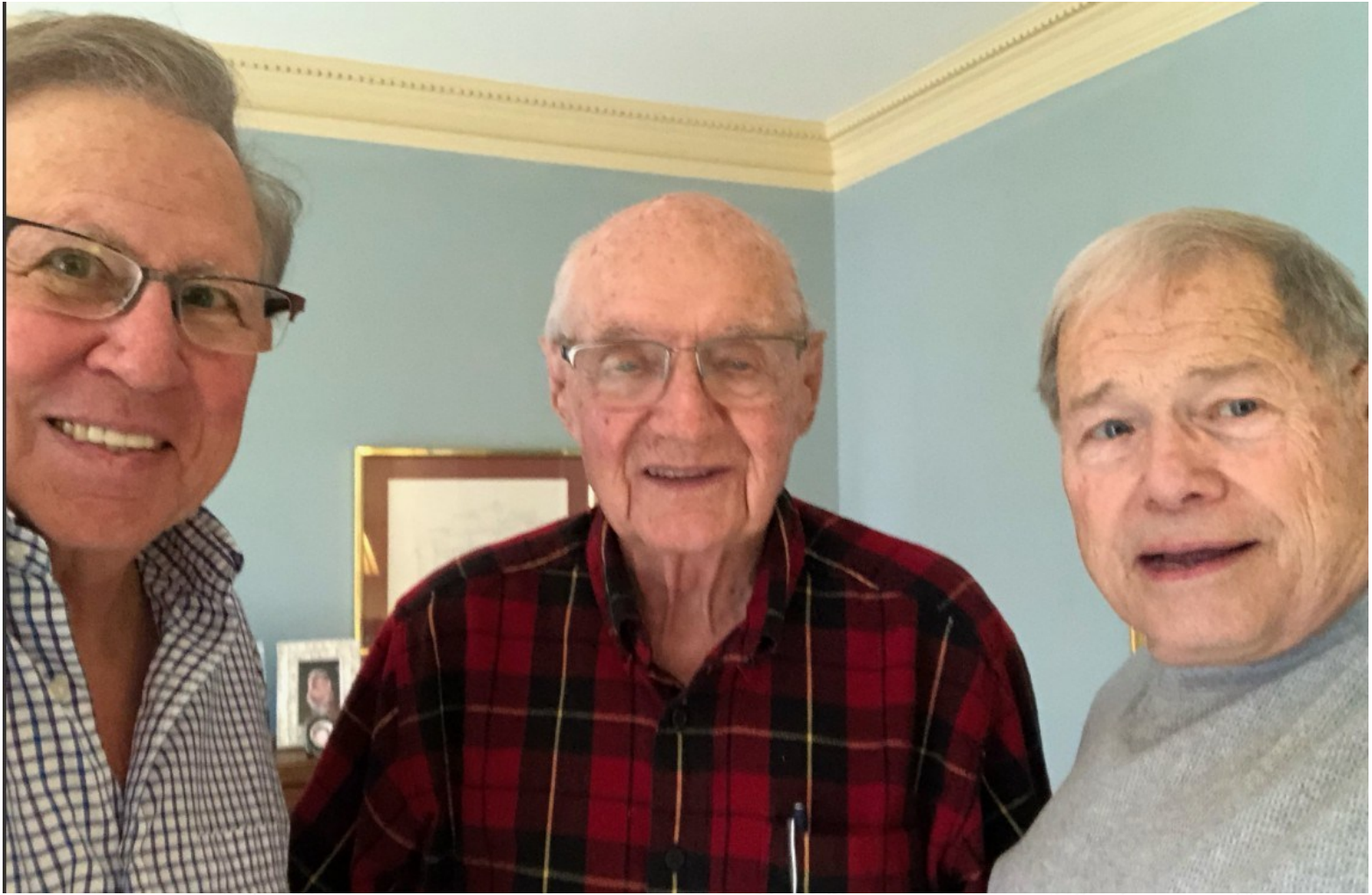

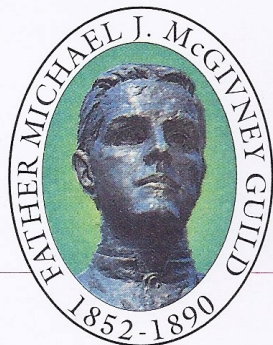
